An assistant scoutmaster from North Philadelphia has been charged with sexually molesting two 11-yearold boys in his Bucks County troop.

Allen Boblitt, 41, of Langdon Street near lioffnagle, surrendered to Philadelphia police shortly before 2 p.m. yesterday.

According to police, Boblitt, an inspector in the construction loan department of the Industrial Valley Bank at 17th and Market streets, is an assistant scoutmaster with Troop 136 in Warminster.

Police began investigating Boblitt after Warminster authorities received a complaint from the parents of an 11-year-old boy in the troop.

Police said the boy told his parents he had gone to Boblitt's home Feb. 14 and had been molested by Boblitt.

After questioning other scouts in the troop, police located a second 11year-old who told investigators that he engaged in sexual acts with Boblitt during an overnight stay at Boblitt's home in January

The boy told police that Boblitt tied

him to a bed and forced him to engage in oral sex.

Boblitt has been charged with involuntary deviate sexual intercourse and two counts each of indecent assault, indecent exposure and corrupting the morals of a minor.

Radnor Township police said yes-terday that a man killed Wednesday night by a Conrail commuter train had been identified as a second-year law student at Villanova University.

The victim was identified as Eugene V. de Luca Jr., 27, of 151 Marple Rd., Haverford Township. De Luca was walking along the tracks when he was struck and killed by the westbound Paoli local passenger train shortly before 11 p.m., about 200 yards east of the Villanova commuter station, officials said.

Radnor Police Chief Maurice Hennessy said the motorman saw de Luca but was unable to stop the train.

Police add fifth name to city's 'most wanted' list

The city Police Department yesiarday added a name to its "five most wanted" list of fugitives.

The addition, Roberto Cruz, 26, is being sought in the robbery and slaying of Richard Breves, who was shot once in the chest while delivering milk in the 200 block of West Stella Street on Sept. 9. Police Inspector Frunk Scafidi described Uruz as an Hispanic male, 5-foot-10, with a heavy build, black hair, dark brown eyes

and a scar inside his right arm near the elbow.

The addition of Cruz followed the surrender Monday of Geraldine Jones, who had been on the list in connection with a stabbing death two months ago. The others on the list are Jerome Lewis, wanted in a series of 15 rapes in the city's Logan section last year; Major George Tillery, wanted in a 1976 slaying; Joseph Miller, wanted on a murder charge, and William Chestnut, wanted in a beating death.

Arraignment delayed for 4 in 5-day siege at Graterford

The arraignment of the four alleged leaders of the five-day hostage siege at Graterford Prison, scheduled for yesterday, has been postponed until March 18, officials said.

The proceeding was tentatively rescheduled because two of the suspects, Calvin Williams, 32, and Lawrence Ellison, 26, could not be returned from federal prisons in other states by yesterday, Montgomery County District Attorney Joseph Smyth said, Joseph Bowen, 36, and Leroy Newsome, 27, have been returned to the federal prison at Lewisburg, Pa., Smyth said.

Smyth had said Monday that state police had filed charges of kidnapping, weapons offenses, criminal conspiracy and attempted escape against the four. The four were transferred to federal prisons at the end of the October incident, which concluded without injury to the hostages. Police allege that the four retreated to a prison kitchen, where they alleg edly held the hostages, after the quartet were spotted trying to escape over a Graterford wall.

SUBJECT: Suspension of Membership of Allen L. Boblitt

I am enclosing a newspaper clipping from the Philadelphia Inquirer, dated March 5, 1982 regarding Allen L. Boblitt, 41, of 8389 Langdon St., Philadelphia, as having surrendered to the Philadelphia Police on charges that he sexually assaulted two Scouts. Boblitt is registered in our Troop 136, sponsored by the Leary Family-Faculty Association, Victoria Road and Henry Avenue, Warminster, Pa. Since then several newspapers have carried these charges and I have personally talked to the police officer in charge of the matter at the onset of events leading up to the newspaper publication.

I have written a letter to Mr. Boblitt, suspending him from membership in the Boy Scouts of America and have enclosed a copy of that letter. Although the Council Commissioner signed the letter in the absence of the Council President the Council President is aware of the action taken.

I have followed, for the most part, the procedures outlined in a communique dated February 1980 from Chief Scout Executive, subject "Procedures for Maintaining Standards of Leadership". I would hope that the information sent to you will suffice until I have filled in a confidential record sheet with more descriptive details of the man.

If there is anything further I must do in this matter to satisfy National Council requirements, please inform me immediately.

After careful review of the allegations made against you in the media today, March 5, 1982, and in discussing this with the Troop Committee Chairman of Troop 136, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended immediately. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that the Boy Scouts of America leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to us explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scouts of America leader should be reinstated.
