We indicated in our letter that we did not feel that he should be registered and asked you send us a confidential record sheet so that we could identify him and close our file.

According to our records, we did not receive the confidential record sheet which we requested. I am enclosing another one so that you may complete it. This will enable registration to be refused wherever the individual may move. It is most important that we have this so that we do not allow some other child to be injured by this individual.

Dear Jerry:

You recently sent me a letter concerning David Francies with Troop 99. It was indicated that this man has been convicted in court of 2nd degree sexual abuse.

I note that the newspaper article also indicates that this person is to have no contact with boys 16 years old or younger and, therefore, I think that most parents would not want him associated with their sons in a Scout troop.

I understand that many times friends do not feel that someone is guilty but the court of law right now takes jurisdiction and precedence in such cases and I would have to say from the information you have sent me, I would refuse to register the individual. We certainly would review the matter in another 4 or 5 years and see what has happened in the meantime.

Please complete the enclosed Confidential Record Sheet so that we may have information that will enable us to identify Mr. Francies.

I certainly will answer any questions I can if you have further observations after receiving my letter.



# MP man sentenced

COQUILLE — ~~David~~ Reeves. According to Assistant District Attorney Glenn Faber, the prosecutor in the case, Francies was placed on two years probation and ordered to participate in a mental health program.

Also, the judge ordered that the defendant take a polygraph test every four months, have no direct contact with boys 16 years old or younger except for relatives and close friends and commit no violations of law other than minor traffic offenses, said Faber.

Francies was convicted earlier this month of the abuse charge.
