# Ex-Margate officer found guilty by jury of indecent assault

Several Explorer scouts watched from the back of the courtroom Wednesday as the man once honored as their Adviser of the Year was found guilty of molesting a former [REDACTED]

A Broward jury deliberated 2½ hours before convicting former Margate police officer Mark Manley, 43, of three counts of indecent assault of a child. The three second-degree felony convictions carry a maximum penalty of 45 years in prison.

The jury acquitted Manley of two counts of capital sexual battery against a child 11 or younger, which would have imposed mandatory life prison terms.

Manley showed no emotion when the verdict was read, but he looked at a row of friends and family members who lowered their heads or broke into silent tears.

Circuit Judge George Shahood scheduled sentencing for Dec. 20.

The youth, now 15, testified that, aside from the sexual assaults that occurred between 1979 and 1982, Manley had acted as a father figure.

Manley fondled him and made him perform sexual acts with assurances it was a normal way to learn about sex, the youth testified.

"I'm proud of my son . . . that he had the courage to get up on the stand," the boy's mother said after the verdict. "He helped to get another child molester off the street."

The boy's mother, who was divorced, allowed Manley to live with her family for about 1½ years. She later described him as a "very sick, very shrewd person" who outwardly seemed to be good to her children and other children.

She met Manley when he took her complaint of a household vandalism in 1979.

Manley still faces charges of sexual battery and indecent assault against the woman's daughter and a neighborhood friend, who said Manley also molested them at the house. The girls were 8 and 9 when sexual acts allegedly began.

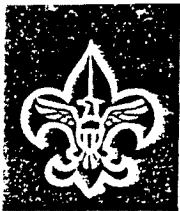
Manley had worked in the Margate Police Department for almost five years as an aide before becoming an officer. He had been the department's juvenile liaison officer from 1982 until his June arrest.

Defense lawyers Harvey Swickle and Bruce Lyons contended the victim's testimony was too inconsistent or vague to convict their client. They also argued the boy may have lied out of bitterness because Manley had moved out of the house.

"What you have here is a man who befriended a boy, befriended a family, moved out, and in 1984 is charged with these offenses," Swickle said.

But prosecutor Joel Lazarus argued Manley "did befriend the family at the time, but the significant word is betrayal."

The boy's mother had "opened her home to him, and what Mark Manley did was steal the innocence of her son," Lazarus said.

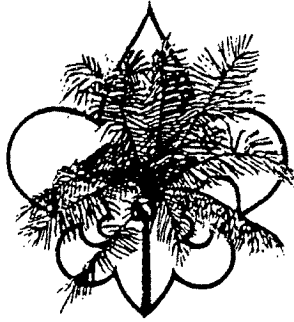

## Margate officer charged with

Margate police arrested the department's youth-liaison officer Friday on charges of sexual battery of a child.

Mark Manley, 42, a Margate policeman for four years, was also charged with lewd, lascivious or indecent assault upon or in the presence of a child.

Police Chief Larry Christopher said the incidents allegedly occurred from 1979 to 1983 and involved a Margate boy, now 13. Police say they expect more charges to follow.

Manley is being held without bond in Broward County Jail. If convicted, he faces life imprisonment on the sexual-battery charge with a minimum, mandatory 25-year sentence.

Manley, a Margate resident, was fired Friday. He was suspended two weeks ago after an internal police investigation gave department officials probable cause to conduct a criminal investigation, Christopher said.

"This child had nothing to do with his police activities," Christopher said. "It was someone he met outside of his activities."

Since May 1982, Manley had been the Margate Police Department's juvenile-liaison officer, charged with overseeing more than 300 runaways, delinquents and incorrigible youths.

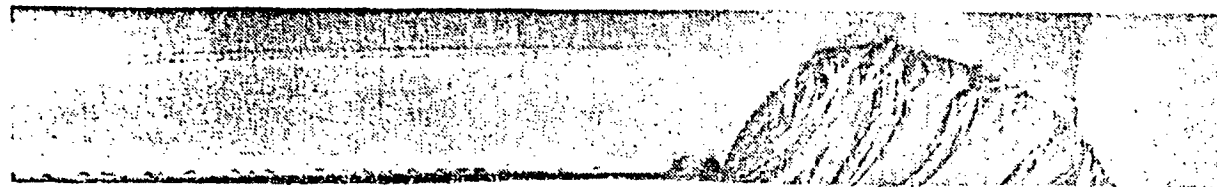
He also was the department's youth liaison, whose duties included visiting Margate Middle School, Margate Elementary School and Coconut Creek High School to lecture about bicycle safety and drug abuse.

Today, May 31st, I discussed by telephone with Lt. [REDACTED] Margate Police Department, the status and circumstances surrounding Mr. Manley suspension, with pay, from the Margate Police Department approximately two weeks ago.

I shared with Lt. [REDACTED] my knowledge of Mr. Manley's background in Scouting which was clean of any violations or abnormal sexual behavior. In return, Lt. [REDACTED] shared with me their existing investigation of Mr. Manley. He is being investigated by the Margate Police Department because of the following accusations:

1. Having active sexual relationship with a 17 year old Explorer Post female member.
2. Having sexual relationship with at least two juveniles under the age of 12.

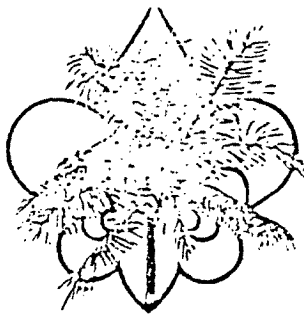
Lt. [REDACTED] feels the investigation will be completed by Wednesday or Thursday of next week, June 6 or 7. He also feels all information will be turned over to the State Attorney's Office for their review and action, which might end up with the Grand Jury.

Lt. [REDACTED] requested that the South Florida Council, through me, not take any action until next Friday, June 8th, which would allow them time to complete their investigation. If any action is taken by the police department that is not in the best interest of the South Florida Council prior to our review of the situation next Friday, he will call or the Chief of Police will call, promptly to inform us.

It is my recommendation that we take no action at this time, but keep completely abreast of the ongoing investigation and behavior of Mark Manley.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.
