Thank you for the information which you have sent us concerning the resignation of Michael Clapp, Scoutmaster of Troop 77.

The confidential record sheet which you sent us is very helpful since it is very complete and will enable us to identify Mr. Clapp should he try to register in any other location.

We would like information if there is any available concerning any other incidents which may have occurred. The situation which you have sent to us indicating only one act is not as strong a case as we would like. There is no question that you could refuse registration in your council but the case does not give us as much evidence as we would like for refusal across the country. If I am interpreting this correctly, nothing actually ever occurred to indicate any sexual acts. You indicate that he wanted this boy to touch him but that he really never did. If you can give us any other incidents which would help to strengthen this situation we certainly would appreciate it.

him. He finally told me why. So

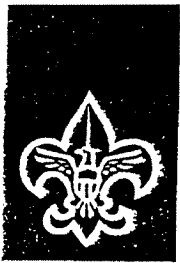

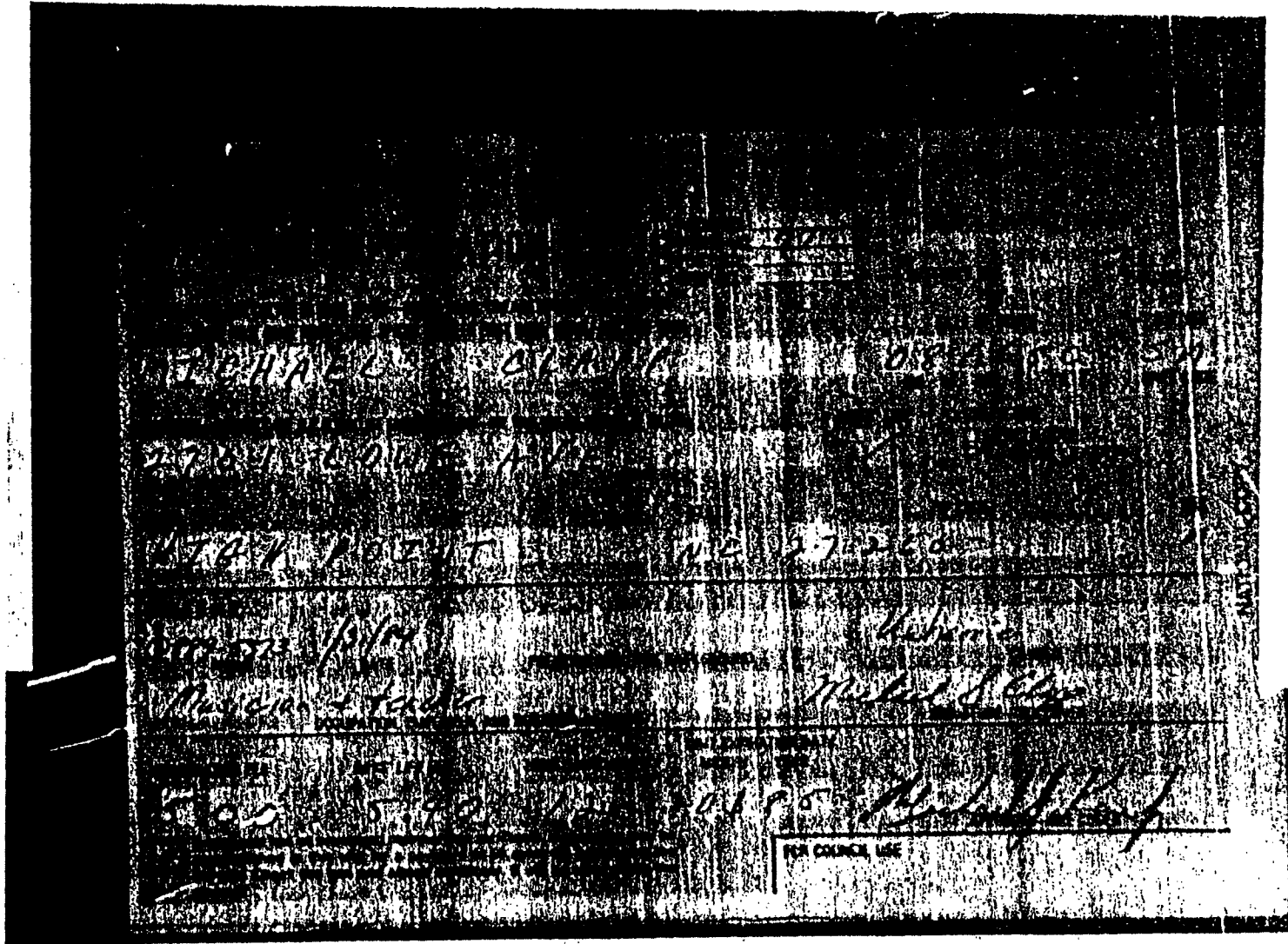
