A former Boy Scout troop leader in Olathe has been convicted in Johnson County District Court of two counts of taking indecent liberties with minors.

John Capra, 37, of 1064 Ashbury. Road, Olathe, agreed that the allegations were true and was found guilty Monday by Judge Gerald Hougland after the judge rejected his attempt to use an insanity defense at the trial:

By stipulating to the allegations without actually pleading guilty, Mr. Capra retained his right to appeal the conviction, Assistant District Attorney Joseph En: Cosgrove Jr. said.

I am filled with anger and pain that I should have to write this letter. Anger...that this person is getting by with doing a great deal of damage everyday in the name of scourting...and hurting young boys more than drugs. Pain...it was reported to you almost three years ago and you ignored me. My ideals of scouting for back with Sir Baden Powell and Country, Mom and Apple Pio. You let me down tremendously. I did contact Johnson County Board of Child Abuse and they found what I am going to tell you...a "Wrongful Act against a minor" and I should take necessary actions.

This is my sen's stery ...

The first year that we were at Camp Naish, I was assistant Camp
Director and trying very hard to be a part of Boy Scouts as it was
new to me. My sons were instructed to be a part of it, work hard
and learn. Our First Aid Headquarters was a log cabin type building
used by the cooks from the sign camp. John Capra was in charge. He
said my son was a good helper and he would like him to assist. That
was the first time he started melesting my son. After camp John called,
and asked if my son could spend a weekend. We were delighted that our
son was going to be around one of the greatest people in scouting.
So far, this may be very bering to you. but as nevices in scouting,
we thought this was a very fortunate happening.

"When I spent the mite with him he insisted I sit en his lap in a very special chair (a recliner),, he would centimue to fondle me between my legs. While we were driving down the reads he would insist I sit next to him, thigh to thigh so he could touch me. At one time a police car went by and he shoved me away from him. He invited me to visit his Nother in western Kansas and we went to see Indian Mounds and in the rocks he kept touching me between my legs. All the time he kept asking me... "You didn't tell your mether, did you?"

No, my son didn8t tell me... I very slowly figured it out for myself. My son wouldn't arswer the phone, got very up-tight when we mentioned the name John Capra. Starting crying, lieing, and having temper tangrams when we pushed that he should go visit John Capra, who was wenderful and top-metch in scouting. This man sexually abused my son and he did it in the name of the Bey Scouts of America. I find no reason why he should get by with this any longer.mmNow that you made me talk about it...think about it...relive it...again. I promise that you will do something about it...we are the Scouts and we are America. Please let me know what you decide., maybe ISII get back in Scouting again.

My heart always hurt me because the man was handicapped until I lemked in my ewn life. My brether is blind and he was Exec. Dir. of Bey Sceuts in Jeplin, Me.

Capra, who walks with leg braces and crutches, last July admitted to Pruett that he had placed his hands on boys' genitals, rubbed their arms and legs and took pictures of them partially clothed.

Several of the assaults occurred at Capra's house, authorities said.

A majority of the sexual assaults centered around Capra's role as a Boy Scout leader, including one attack that occurred at a Boy Scout camp in Bonner Springs, authorities said.

- In two separate sexual assaults, that occurred at Capra's house last spring, the man rubbed his hand on the boys' genitals to teach them the location of pressure points, authorities said. The boys were at Capra's house working on merit badges.

The boys involved in the sexual assaults range in age from 11 to 16, investigators said.

During the hearing Monday, Cosgrove played the 20-minute tape statement Capra gave to police. It is the first time the statement has been played in open court.

The tape was played during a hearing before District Judge Gerald Hougland to determine whether Capra voluntarily gave the statement to police.

.. Defense attorney Joe Dioszeghy argued that Pruett coerced Capra into making the statement by being "overly nice" to him. Pruett admitted on the stand that he told Capra he would help him receive counseling for his problems, but denied ever coercing the man into confessing.

· Hougland ruled that Pruett 'acted properly in his interview with Capra.

Dan Wheatcroft, executive director of the Heart of America · Boy Scout Council, said recently that Capra was acting as a volunteer "merit badge - counselor" when he is alleged to have committed the sexual acts - Capra remains free on a \$10,0 bond.

Former boy scout leader waives hearing on sexual abuse charges

An Olathe man accused of sexually abusing three boys waived preliminary hearing Monday before Johnson County District Court Judge James H. Bradley.

John R. Capra, 36, a former volunteer merit badge counselor for the

Boy Scouts of America, will be formally arraigned Sept. 26 before Judge Earle D. Jones.

Capra was originally charged on July 11 with one count of taking indecent liberties with a child in an incident that allegedly occurred in April. Two charges in-

volving other youths were later added.

A c c o r d i n g t o authorities, the three youths were Boy Scout members who had gone to Capra's house earlier this year for advice on merit badge projects. An investigation is continuing to see if other youths were involved.

- A former Olathe Boy Scout leader pleaded not guilty Wednesday in Johnson County District Court to charges of taking indecent liberties with a 13-year-old scout and two other boys, the county prosecutor said.

The defendant, 36-year-old John R. Capra of 1064 Ashbury Road, was charged in June with fondling a scout April 26 at the man's home. Two more sex charges were filed in July.

Associate Judge Earle D. Jones scheduled an Oct. 23 hearing to set a trial date, District Attorney Dennis Moore said.

Former scout leader sentenced to prison

Former Clathe Boy Scout lead er John Capra was sentenced Thursday to 4-15 years in prison

for molesting two young boys.

However, it's not known whether the 37-year-old Capra will be sent to prison or granted

Johnson County District Judge Jonnson County District Judge Gerald Houghand sentenced Capra to prison and denied pro-Capra to prison and denied pro-bation, but then allowed Capra to remain free on a \$10,000 bond pending an appearance before the Johnson County Parole Board at 2

p.m. May 9.
At that time, the parole board, comprised of the judges in the criminal division, will decide whether to uphold Hougland's sentence or grant Capra proba-

Dressed in a blue business suit, the handicapped Capra kept his head down during the 45-minute hearing. He kept his face turned away from television cameras in

At the hearing, defense attorney Joe Dioazeghy asked for bench probation, telling Hougland that any prison sentence would be "a death sentence" for Capra because of his handicaps and his convictions on child molestation

"In John Capra's case, even three or four months in prison, is a death sentence," Dioszeghy

said.
"In Mr. Capra's case there is absolutely no reason to send him to prison other than to punish him and to send a message to the community. And, as I have said before, I don't think the message would be perceived the way we

want it to be perceived."

However, Joseph Cosgrove Jr.,
an assistant Johnson County dis-trict attorney, argued that Capra should be placed in prison for his crimes, saying society should send a message that child lesters will be dealt with stero-

ly.
"Sentencing in this case should send a message that serious sex abuses of children will be dealt with sternly by the law," he said."
"We need to send a message to those individuals who work with children's groups. Mr. Capra is; not a minor sex offender. His crimes were of significant magnitude. Finally, society has a legitimate interest in punish-

Hougland found Capra guilty Hougland found Capra guilty March 20 of two counts of taking indecent liberties with a minor.

Although Hougland found Capra guilty, Capra did not enter a plea in the case, but simply stipulated to a set of facts that would have been presented if the case has been tried. case has been tried

According to the stipulation Capra admitted to Hougland that on several dillum occasions Capra fondled the genitals of atleast three boys who were at his Olathe residence working on Boy

Scout ment badges.

During the hearing Thursday, During the hearing Thursday, Diosteghy strongly urged that Capra be granted probation, indicating the charges against Capra involved minimal touching. Diosteghy said Capra, who walks with braces, has been

"physically handicapped for the

"physically handicapped for the entirety of his life."
"The man never, ever had the normal relationships all of us have had growing up." Dieszeghy said, indicating that Capra's foodling was similar to what small children do to each other.
"This is a man who is 37 years of

John Capra, a former Boy Scout leader, was originally sentenced April 25 to 4-15 years in prison by District Judge Gerald Hougiand.

However, defense attorney Joe Dioszeghy appealed Hougland's sentence to the parole board,

The parole board to usually composed of the four criminal judges in Johnson County District An-Court but at Thursday's hearing stonly two members of the board were present . Hougland and District Judge William Gray.

At the hearing, Hougland told the 37-year-old Capra that the board decided to grant him probetion because his actions involve ed only minimal touching and did not include any aggravated circumstances or homosexual activities,

... Several weeks ago, Capra admitted to touching the boys on their genitals, but said he quit when the boys asked him to. The boys were about 13 years old when the molestations occurred.

According to court testimony the molestations occurred while Capra was working as a volunteer Boy Scout counselor. Some of the molestations occurred at Capra's Olathe residence while the boys were there working on merit badges. The others occurred at a Boy Scout camp.

As part of his probation, Capra's activities with Joung boys, will be restricted. Those restrictions will be outlined by the Johnson County probation department.

The crippled Capra, who walks with the aid of braces and crutches, has remained free on a \$10,000 bond since his arrest last summer.

Johnson County District Aty's torney Dennis Moore was not pleased with the parole board's decision.

"I agree with 90 percent of the decisions the judges make," he said. "But I disagree with this, one. When you've got cases involving the molestation of several

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
