

Il was placed in a back room to sleep. At one point sometime in the night (with all lights out) house come in to skeck on: me. after feeling various parts of my lody he placed his hand within my underwar and reited his hand on my pulse area. I started which caused his daily retreat from the room. He evidently thought of had been asleep. I wear. the above statement to be the truth!

I have been asked to sign a statement concerning the moral behavior of Rogce Adkins. I have full know-ledge of the scope of this accusation and I, in no way, compose this statement with the least bit of malice, predjudice, or discreprency against his personality, qualifications, leadership ability, etc.

on a saturday right while camping with troop 55 at the River Bend campsite at Camp Arrowhead Rayce Adkins and I decided to tent together. I was awaken by Royce Adkins massign my penis and public area. I was very deeply shocked and surprised because I had aquired an admiration and respect for him in the past. I ran out of the tent and walked around for about five minutes. It was very cold and I started coughing and I couldn't stop so I didn't stay out in the cold and I went to get under the blankets. When I layed down Royce Adkins said he would goose me the next time I coughed and he did, And when he did I hit him. Then he grabbed my hand And tried to make me tough touch his public area so I hit him again. Then he reached for me again and I said, If you want to see it wait til day light." this is when he stopped.

I swear that this statement is true and will testify that it is valid and will, at any time, if asked to do so, give a personal account to it as long as I will not jepordize myself when doing so.

In mg. opinion this act should not, by any circumstances, be duplicated at any time in the future. Because this act of homosexuality could very easily ruin the image of the Boy. Scout movement as well as ruin the lives of many young citizens, I think that Royce. Adkins should be expeled from the hath, scorting movement. I certify that this statement is valid and by no means an exaduration.
