



Dear Chief Gallagher:

Reference is made to our recent telephone conversation and your request for information on the above mentioned subject.

Herman Miles Perkins Jr. was born on 2 April 1934 in Baltimore, Maryland. He has used many aliases including, Lt. H. M. Perkins, Lt. Harry L. Sawyer, Jack Turrence, Jim Colby, Lt. Shafer and Lt. Larkin of the American Police Association.

In June of 1964 Perkins was the victim of a reported assault, which later was determined to be a mere domestic quarrel. It was learned at this time that Perkins had been under periodic psychiatric care since the age of 8 years in Baltimore, Maryland and Lynchburg, Virginia. In 1964 Perkins was under the care of Doctors Duncan and Babcock at St. Anthony's Hospital, St. Petersburg, Florida.

In 1966 information was received that Perkins was posing as a State Beverage Agent, on numerous occasions he was found to be carrying a tear gas pistol, and bearing an official appearing identification and badge.

In November, 1971 information was received that Perkins now publishes a magazine titled "The Midnighter" which allegedly keeps current with suncoast activities. It was further learned that there have been numerous derogatory statements made in it, pertaining to Madeira Beach City Councilmen. This subject in many instances passed himself off as a police officer to obtain information that would otherwise be confidential.

Perkins has used this ruse many times to establish himself as founder and manager of the American Police Association and has actively solicited funds for advertising in the "Homo Safety Manual" throughout the Pinellas County Area. To the knowledge of this Unit this magazine was never published and the funds collected were routed to his personal use.


On 3 April 71 the St. Petersburg Police Department submitted Perkins as a submission to the Tampa Bay Area Intelligence Unit files and number 495 was assigned. The following criminal record is shown for the subject.

- A. Arrested by Baltimore County Police in Towson, Maryland, 4 February 53 for Disorderly Conduct.
- B. Arrested by the Police Department Lynchburg, Virginia, 14 April 1963 for Cursing and Abusiveness.
- C. Arrested by the Tampa Police Department 14 December 1966 for Lewd and Lascivious Conduct by Masturbation and fined \$150.00 or 50 days.

His present address is 11010 Freedom Boulevard, in Seminole, Florida and lives with his wife Anna B. Perkins. His records in this department show that he has been married to a Sarah Perkins and her home is listed 3616 1/2 Campbell Avenue, in Lynchburg, Virginia.


