## America's manpower begins with BOYPOWER

Dear Mr. Ernst:

I have just taken action on a most unfortunate circumstance that occurred recently at Camp Rainey Mountain, Scout Reservation of the Northeast Georgia Council.

A telephone call from the Camp Director alerted me to a most grievous act that had taken place between the Waterfront Staff Director and a counselor-in-training. After a personal investigation into the matter, the facts are listed below:

The 14-year old C.I.T. (Counselor-In-Training) checked-in to camp on June 28, 1972, to begin two weeks of staff work on the waterfront. Upon arrival, he was taken to the private quarters of James H. Brown and told to strip for an initiation. James Brown set upon the Scout: striking him with his fist in the throat and neck, kneeing him in the groin, striking his buttocks with a paddle, and then hitting his vital organs with a small leather whip. The C.I.T. was literally picked off the ground by his breasts. Brown then told the C.I.T. to report to him on two other occasions. Out of fear, the Scout reported as ordered and was stripped again-on this occasion he told that he was to be checked for a hernia. The Scout was

stripped, towels were placed under his buttocks and an electric massager was placed under his testicles. The C.I.T. was ordered to report again and asked if he would like to be cut in two places on his body. The Scout finally overcame his fear, and, in the presence of another member of the waterfront staff, asked Brown to leave him alone. His action was backed up by the staff member, who had no prior knowledge of what was going on. The Scout then called his parents, who came immediately to investigate.

Upon arrival at camp, the father confronted the Camp Director, who immediately called me. When I arrived at camp, the father and Scout met me and the story was recounted in detail. The details of the story were exactly as had been recounted to the Camp Director. The Scout indicated that bruises had been in evidence, but had disappeared after a few days. The father's first reaction was to swear out a complaint with local authorities and have Brown arrested. While waiting for me to arrive, he decided against this action because of the undue harm to the camp and to Scouting and decided to leave the action to me. The father was thanked for his understanding.

The Camp Director, Business Manager (both District Executives of our Council) and I then confronted Brown with the accusation. He did not deny any part of the afore-mentioned actions and was dismissed from camp immediately. I also recommended that he seek medical help and that he not plan any further participation in the Boy Scout program at anytime, anywhere.

One member of the camp staff had known Brown quite well and indicated that he had noted a radical change in Brown since his returning from Viet Nam in 1971. This staff member suspected homosexual tendencies, but had absolutely no proof.

James H. Brown has been extremely active in Scouting while at Fort Bragg, N.C. An Eagle Scout, he has conducted Jr. Leader Training for the Occoneechee Council in Raleigh, N.C. He came to us highly recommended and up to this point we considered him one of the top men on the summer camp staff.

We recommend that James H. Brown be placed on the confidential list of the Boy Scouts of America and not be registered in any capacity.
