

Please be advised that the defendant, Fred Modica, was indicted under the above captioned indistments for numerous counts involving Sodomy, Sexual Abuse, Sexual Misconduct and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, and that on September 10, 1973, the defendant pleaded guilty under Indictment #3257/1973 to the crime of Attempted Sodomy in the First Degree (a Class C Felony) before Mr. Justice David Epstein, to cover all counts of both indictments. He is presently awaiting sentence.
