Dear Sir:

In reference to our conversation at this office in regards to the file, from our office involving Bert Garwood. Bert was a counsler at the Boy Scout Camp Lake Metigoshe, North Dakota, at the present time of this report May 21, 1973 and had been for the past several years.

This office recieved several calls regarding membership cards and post cars, being issued and sent to a number of young boys ages 12 to 14 years old. The boys are Boy Scouts or involved with Scouting and had attended Scout Camp at Lake Metigoshe in the past and were planning to attend this summer.

As a result of an investigation made by myself, I met with 6 young boys along with their parents in the City of Westhope on May 27, 1973. The boys stated they had all recieved membership cards, through the Great Garwood Club. They also recieved Postcars dated May 25, 1973, Souris, North Dakota. I am enclosing photostatic copy of the post card of both sides, as well as picture of Mr. Garwood, only the one side of the back side is blank.

Talking with the boys and parents and hearing the alligations made against Bert Garwood, I felt that Bert as a Counsler and leader of our young boys at a cmp could result in a serious situation for our young people.

The names of the boys and parents involved with this investigation will not be mentioned.

Alligations made involved activities at the Boy Scout Camp, the past several years. Just to mention a few of them, one was, he at times tried to, or ask, some of the boys to go into the bush with him and take part in

a unusal sexual behavior. Another was exposing himself and playing with himself many, many times.

The past week, Bert had been picking up the boys, at their homes or off the streets and taking them for a ride in his car. At times would change drivers, letting one of them drive the vehicle, if they would not tell anyone what was going on. Bert had a tape recorder in his car and while some one else was driving he would cut a tape, the opening statement would be, (I do not recall the excat words, but didn't make sense, as far as I was concerned), but he was suppose to turn this tape over to some superior of his. Also would use the tape while driving and while taping would drive in a very reckless manner, apparently trying to frighten the boys in the car. He would change drivers again and w would then be in the back seat with some of the boys, and attempting to play with them or playing with himself. At one time he had one of the boys with his hands around his throat attempting to either choke him, or scare him.

At this point, early in the morning of May 27,1973, (3:30) a.m., I left the boys and parents and went directly to the Garwood farm, where I met with Bert, and his Mother and Father. I approached them with some of the information I had. Bert denied some and admitted some. He denied especially the part which I consider, very, very, dangerous, the alligation of choking. However he did say, he told the boy he was going to choke him just to scare him. Talking to his parents, they told me he was enrolled in ROTC at the University and he was a Junior there. They stated he had been seeing a psychiatrist and they would take immidate steps for counseling with his psychatrist. A follow up by this office found this had been done, as I did check with his psychatrist.

For this reason, I called Mr. Don Martin whom I am acquainted with and knew he is a leader in Boy Scouts. I suggested to Mr. Martin that Bert as a leader of the Scouts, should be severed at this time. Until Bud Olson came to my office in September, this office was unaware of any action the Scouts had taken.

I feel now, that Bert Garwood and his involvement which appears to be boys under 15 years of age and that Scout activities with the Scouts could result in a dangerous or even a criminal act, if allowed to continue, camping and taking part with our young people in the open spaces.

We have a file on this, at our office it it can be of any further assisstance to you.
