Dear Paul:

I met with Robert Whitlock and a group of district and unit committee volunteers last week to discuss our Cease and Desist letter with him. He finally agreed that he would cease all activities with the Scout Troop and we will allow him to return to participation in the troop again in about three or four months as just an interested parent. We made it very clear that he was to have no activity at all with boys once he returns to the troop. We still can't prove that there have been any problems with Bob during the last five years, either in scouting or out of scouting. We told him that we did not question the fact that he was cured after psychiatric treatment but at this time it was best for all that he resign from the unit.

I really don't expect any further problems with Bob, unless someone in the pack or troop starts gossiping too much.

I thought you would be interested in knowing the outcome of this situation.

After carefull review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you seek to have this decision reviewed, please write to me. I will then see to it that a committee of three Boy Scout volunteers meets with you to consider your case.

You will be required to return all registration cards to the Detroit Area Council that are now in your possession.
