THE COURT: The Court is calling case number A075971,

THE COURT: The defendant was charged in this
Information with three counts of violation of Section 288
Penal Code, being Counts I, III, and V, and two counts of
288a, Subsection (c) Penal Code, being Counts II and IV. He
was arraigned May 26th, 1977, and pleaded not guilty.

On July 12th, 1977, he entered a change of plea of guilty to Counts I, III, and V. The District Attorney's effice in a case settlement agreement premised to dismiss Counts II and IV at the time of sentence and Counts I, III, and V.

Thereafter, M.D.S.O. proceedings were conducted and terminated and criminal proceedings were resumed.

The matter is on calendar today for consideration of the defendant's obligation for probation. I've read and considered the probation reports and the doctors' reports.

Mr. Emmer, do you wish to be heard?

MR. EMMER: Mo, your Monor. I've gone over the reports and I'm willing to submit it on the basis of the report.

I notice that there was a recommendation for possible therapy or treatment at Vacaville recommended. I would concur. Submitted.

THE COURT: Hr. Bagration, is there any legal cause

that you have to show why judgment should not now be prenounced?

THE DEFENDANT: No, your Honor.

THE COURT: Very well. As to each count, probation is denied. This is because the defendant has a long history of criminal offenses and is a fugitive from another state. He's attempted to avoid discovery by changing his name and he misused a position of trust for his own purposes at the expense of young, impressionable boys who were mistreated and injured and defenseless and impressionable and at an emotional age.

This type of offense against the children of the community certainly is one of the most anti-social type of offenses. I think that "r. Bagration's history of criminal behavior does furnish a sound basis for the belief that he is a compulsive pedenhiliae, and if allowed his freedom would again prev on young boys. The doctors' reports indicate essentially the same, at least the report that I feel is grounded on the most careful analysis. Hospitalization would not be an adequate safequard, nor is there any indication that would be of any success in treating the underlying anti-social make-up of this defendant.

Therefore, the defendant will be sentenced to State Prison, and because of these circumstances the Court will impose a maximum centence available to the Court, and that is that each count run consecutive to each other.



Bagration, formerly scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 222, has a lengthy arrest record for sexual offenses. He is currently under indictment by a New York grand jury which has charged him in three similar incidents dating from 1971.

The confessed child molester lived in an apartment at 1519 26th St. at the time of his arrest. A police search of the apartment resulted in the seizure of a quantity of slides depicting young boys involved in sexual acts, along with a variety of cameras and camera equipment.

Bagration worked as a counselor for a Marina del Rey employment agency at the time of his arrest. He was apprehended April 26 following an investigation by Los Angeles and Santa Monica police.

Officers began their investigation after an informant gave them slides showing young children involved in sexual activity. The slides allegedly came from the home where Bagration had lived in Venice before moving to Santa Monica.

Bagration led a Boy Scout troop which met Monday evenings at Franklin School. According to Santa



May 11, 1977:

Talked to Don Emmer by phone. He gave me information that he was going to represent Mike Ross at his preliminary hearing on May 12, 1977, Santa Monica Superior Court. He said that currently, Mike faces five charges involving three boys whose last names are the first two boys are involved in two charges - child molestation and oral copulation. The boy is involved in only one charge of child molestation. The only boy I am aware of having been registered with the Boy Scouts of America. He was registered as a Scout in Troop 222, Santa Monica District in December 1976 and did not reregister in January of 1977.

I understand that the troop on occasion for several months prior to actually registering. He was known as the troop mascot.

Don Emmer informed me that Mike had been arrested five times in New York for child molestation between 1960 and 1971. He was convicted three times and acquitted once. The fifth arrest is still pending because Mike jumped bond and fled to California prior to disposition of the case.

Emmer said that the probability exists of an outstanding Federal warrant for flight to avoid prosecution but he is not positive of this. Ross served two jail sentences in New York and received three years' probation on the third conviction.

Emmer stated that Ross was going to plead guilty to the current charges because he felt there would probably be additional charges filed should these not be disposed of promptly.

July 12, 1977:

Don Emmer called informing me of the fact that Mike Ross, under the name of Allen Bagration, had pled guilty to three charges in return for the District Attorney dropping the remaining two charges. Sentencing will take place

on August 2, 1977. All three charges carry a 3 year-to-life sentence. This will probably turn out to be either 5 years or 15 years, depending upon whether or not the judge decides on the three sentences being concurrent or consecutive.

New York filed five charges on July 8 in Santa Monica Division, Superior Court against Allen Bagration and he will be extradited to New York following his sentencing here on August 2. His sentences will probably be served in New York following conviction. Should his ultimate sentence be less than the California sentence, he would be returned here to complete the total California sentence.

Received a call from Officer Worth of the Los Angeles Police Department requesting me to check the Confidential File on

Allan Pagration

Officer Worth informed me that Mike Ross had served two years at Rikers Island Prison in New York for child molestation. He had teaching credentials at one time but they had been revoked because of child molestation charges. Officer Worth also stated that Mike had jumped bail and fled New York prior to sentencing on one or more convictions of child molestation.

May 2, 1977 - 11:30 AH

Called Paul Ernst at National Personnel and asked him to run a check on Allan Pagration. His report was negative.

May 2,1977 - 11:40 AM

I called Officer Worth and reported these negative findings. He was very critical of the Boy Scouts of America and this council for permitting individuals like Mike Ross to become Scout leaders. He stated that he felt the Scouting organization had a responsibility to insure that the Scouts maintained the "American flag, apple pie, all the good impressions that the public has of Scouting". Worth stated that in view of the fact that we knew about Mike two years ago and did nothing about it left us open to criticism. I told him that I was not aware of any such notification.

He said that Mr. had told us of a problem with Mike Ross and that a Santa Monica school principal, had also discussed the problem with Maury Fulkerson of our staff. I confirmed that Maury had talked with Mr. concerning Mr. and that we had conducted with Mr. Schwartz to secure a signed complaint giving details of any charges being made. This verbal request was followed by a letter confirming the request. No such complaint has been received to date. Therefore, no action could be taken.

Officer Worth stated that the police report was going to be very critical of the Boy Scouts concerning the apparent laxness in the control over the type of leader-ship we have. He said he felt that we might go so far as to request a fingerprint

check on leaders before they become active.

I explained the Boy Scouts procedure of registration to Officer Worth, as well as the selection process of securing a Scoutmaster. I also explained the procedure involved in the Confidential File maintained by National. He did not seem satisfied with our methods.

I closed our conversation with a request for any pattern or mold that he could provide that would enable us to use satisfactory measure to the our leaders.

May 2, 1977 - 2:00 PM

Talked to Mr. Fulkerson about the school principal report concerning Mike Ross. He confirmed the facts I had given Officer Worth were correct. He further stated that at no time did he have any communication concerning Mike from Mr. Washington, and did not feel that Mr. was aware of his discussions with Principal

Mr. Fulkerson told me that Brian Campbell and a Mr. Flascher had visited Mike at the Los Angeles County jail sometime during the previous weekend. The purpose of this visit is not known.

May 3, 1977 - 3:30 PM

I called Don Emmer regarding Wood Badge. During our conversation, he said that in all probability, he would not be representing Mr. Ross but that he had talked with him and was of the opinion that Mike was not going to fight any of the current child molestation charges against him. Emmer further told me that the pictures that the police showed me are police prints of colored slides Mike had taken five years ago. Emmer also stated that Mr. Ross had given his power of attorney to a Mr. Schwartz (so far as I know, it is not the school principal) who would dispose of his personal property. Don Emmer also told me that Mike's brother, who is a well known New York photographer and a singer with the Metropolitan Opera, had no plans for posting bail for Mike since he had forfeited the last bond he had posted in New York when Mike fled to avoid sentencing. Mr. Emmer said he feels that Mike would probably be defended by a public defender and that he would probably plead guilty to some of the current charges: following this, he would be extradited to New York to face the outstanding warrant for him there.

If New York sentences him to prison/jor treatment, then California probably would not sentence him here.

Don Emmer said Mike's real name (changed legally following a conviction in New York) is Alan David Peter Bagration. Don and Hr. Schwartz, who is a close personal friend of Mike's brother, are going to meet with Mike tonight. I told Emmer to have Mr. Schwartz to contact me for help in cleaning up Scouting records and securing the Scout material Mike has in his apartment.

May 3, 1977 - 4:15 PM

Talked to Mr. Fulkerson. He said Mike had Scout-O-Rama tickets for two units in addition to several uniforms which belong to the district uniform exchange, and all of the records and supplies of Troop 222. I will try to secure this material from Mr. Schwartz as soon as possible.

The following information will bring you up-to-date on the charges which have been filed by the Los Angeles & Santa Monica Police Departments against Mike Ross:

April 27, 1977 - 3:00 P.M.

FRANCH

Los Angeles Police Department officers Don Worth and Doug Elder informed me that Mike Ross had been arrested and served with a warrant executed at his residence; that he was being held in Santa Monica on \$25,000 bail. They asked if I knew him and I confirmed that I did.

They requested boy registration records of troops Mike Ross had been affiliated with in this area. I supplied photocopies of 1975 and 1976 charters of Troops 12 and 222 in the Santa Monica District and current year charter for Troop 222.

They asked for any information I might have concerning his Scouting history prior to registering in this council. I had none, other than the fact that Mike had indicated to me in conversation that he had been active some place back east.

They showed me a series of about 15 pornographic pictures of boys aged 10 to 15 years actively engaged in homosexual acts and asked if I could identify any of the boys. I could not. Maury Fulkerson came in at this time and they asked him if he could identify any of the boys in these pictures. He stated he recognized one of the boys as having worked at the Santa Monica Reclamation Center but did not know him by name or unit.

The officers asked if Scouting could check on prior Scouting registration of any of the following names:

Allen Grossman Al Grossman Poss Allen Grossman

They felt this was the prior name of Mike Ross and stated that as such, he had a record of prior arrests and/or conviction under one of these names. One such prior case concerned the death of a seven-year-old.

The officers felt he might have been registered in the New York area under one of these names. I told them we would check with National Personnel and see if such information was available and then call them.

April 27, 1977 - Approximately 4:45 P.M.

I returned a call from Don Emmer and found he had called me to inform me of Mike's arrest. Mike had contacted him prior to the time of the arrest for legal advice concerning his problem. Don Emmer did not indicate whether or not he had agreed to represent Mike. I told Don that I had talked to the Los Angeles Police Department concerning Mike and that I knew of his arrest on a child molestation charge.

April 28, 1977 - 9:30 A.M.

I took a call for Maury Fulkerson at the Valley office from Mr. Smart of the Evening Outlook concerning Mike's arrest. I confirmed that Mike was a Scoutmaster in the Santa Monica District and had been for the past year and a half. I also informed him that Mike had been active in Scouting in this area for about two and a half years.

April 28, 1977 - 10:30 A.M.

Dave Mickelsen requested that I call Personnel at National and I did. I spoke to Paul Ernst and told him of the request from the Los Angeles Police Department about Grossman. He checked the confidential list and said they had no information on anyone named Grossman. He also stated that they would have no adult registration information except for the past two years, which we had in this council.

Paul requested that we supply information to National as it develops, including statements which are issued, charges, news articles, and - most important - final disposition of the case.

April 28, 1977 - 12:45 RM

I called Sam Jones at the Los Angeles Council office and gave him information that I had concerning Mike Ross and informed him that all requests for information would be directed to him. Sam stated he would call Bill Kephart and tell him of the pending action.

April 28, 1977 - 1:00 P.H.

I arrived at the Douglas Scout Service Center and was given notes by Doris Grabhorn of a phone conversation she had with Mike Ross during the morning. Dorie said Officers Warren and Wood of the Santa Monica Police Department had come into the office approximately 30 minutes following Mike's call and they requested a photocopy of her notes from the phone conversation. We supplied the officers with a copy of these notes.

A 40-year-old Santa Monica scoutmaster was arrested on suspicion of child molesting following a joint investigation by Santa Monica and Los. Angeles police, authorities reported. Michael A. Ross, employment counselor for a Venice employment agency, was booked at Santa Monica Jail. The alleged offense, involving two boys, aged 11 and 14, occurred last July, police said.

Scoutmaster Accused Of Child Molesting

A 40-year-old Santa Monica scoutmaster has been booked on suspicion of child molesting in connection with alleged sexual misconduct involving three Santa Monica boys, one of whom attended the man's scout meeting at Franklin Elementary School, police reported.

Michael Allen Ross of 1519 26th Street was arrested Tuesday at a Marina del Rey employment agency, where he works as a counselor. He was being held today on \$25,000 bail.

Ross, who is the leader of Boy Scout Troop 222, was taken into custody following an investigation by Santa Monica and Los Angeles police.

Police said their investigation began in March after an informant gave them slides showing men engaging in lewd acts with children. The slides allegedly came from Ross's home in Venice. He later moved to Santa Monica.

Venice police reportedly have linked Ross to a child-molesting incident involving two of the boys, ages 11 and 14. That incident allegedly occurred in Venice last July. Ross reportedly met one of the boys through scouting. Santa Monica police said.

A Santa Monica police representative said investigators are interviewing several members of Troop 222. The representative added that one boy, who was not a member of the troop but who attended Monday night meetings at Franklin School, said Ross molested him during a recent meeting.

The spokesman said a complaint was to be sought from the district attorney's office against .Ross in connection with that incident.

Venice and Santa Monica police, armed with a search warrant signed by Santa Monica Municipal Judge Robert Thomas, went to Ross's home Tuesday and confiscated camera equipment and numerous undeveloped rolls of film. Police were unable to say if there were any lewd pictures in any of the material confiscated.

A spokesman for the Boy Scouts Great Western Council said Ross has been leader of Troop 222 for the past 1½ years and has served as a volunteer with the organization for the past 2½ years.

on 3-28-77 Detective A. Warren was contacted at headquarters by a male juvenile, 1033 6th Street, #202, Santa Monica, telephone 394-5270, age 16 years of age. Advised Det. Warren that he and another juvenile, 15 year old 451-2000, who resided in the area of Lincoln and Marguerita, had been shown slides (photographic slides) on 3-27-77 at home by a male adult named Ralph (later identified as Ralph Bonnell, 1236 Euclid, #103, Santa Monica, telephone 394-7940). These slides had depicted sexual contact between young boys such as oral copulation and anal intercourse. Stated that they had been told by Ralph that he had taken the slides away from a man named Michael Ross and that Ross had taken the slides himself.

After receipt of the above information, an investigation was initiated which resulted in the identification of Ralph Bonnell as being the person in possession of the aforementioned slides. On 4-5-77 Ralph Bonnell came to headquarters where he turned over to Investigators Warren and Wood a white plastic container which contained twenty-two color slides. Bonnell stated he had obtained the slides from the home of Michael Ross, who then lived on Indiana in Venice. That at that time he was leasing a garage from Ross and had permission to use the house for bathroom facilities. He had observed the slides on the coffee table in August of 1976, had been very incensed that Michael Ross would have pictures of that type and had confronted Ross with the slides, then had beat him up because he was so angry over having seen the slides.

Bonnell stated that Michael Ross had not admitted to him that he had taken the slides, however, Bonnell believed Ross made the slides because he recognized a green room divider in the slides as one belonging to Ross. Bonnell also related that Ross owns considerable photographic equipment, including cameras and photo enlargers. He also stated that Ross keeps a black metal box in his house which is kept locked with three pedlocks on each hasp and that this box is approximately three feet by two feet in size. He stated Ross is very protective of the box and would not let him, Bonnell, touch or move the box.

Investigation, revealed that Michael Ross is presently residing at 1519 26th Street, #B, Santa Monica, telephone 828-0029, and is employed as an Employment Counselor at Apple One Employment Agency, 2534 Lincoln Blvd., Marina Dal Rey. It was further learned that Michael Ross is a Boy Scout Leader in charge of Troop 222 which meets on Monday nights at Franklin School in Santa Manica.

Because of Bonnell's statement that he had taken the slides from a residence in Venice, contact was made with LAPD regarding the possibility of the slides had been made in their jurisdiction. Efforts by both Santa Monica and L. A. P. D. investigators to identify the young boys shown in the slides engaging in the sexual activities proved negative.

After completion of the search, Ross was then transported to Santa Monica Police Department where he was booked for 288 P.C.



Your affiant, Officer D. E. Elder, #16112, is currently assimmed to the Juvenile Division, Los Angeles Police Department, Sexual Exploitation Unit, and has been so assigned for six months. Your affiant has participated in excess of fifty investigations involving sexual xx2300itation and child molest. Your affiant has made numerous arrests for crimes of sexual exploitation and childmolest. Your affiant has interviewed numerous victims of sexual exploitation and child molest. Your affiant has interviewed several adults who were admitted child molestors. Your affiant has previous juvenile investigative experience. Your affiant has 11 been a Los Angeles police officer for six and one-half 12 :3 vears. 14 Your affiant received information from Investigator :5 Arthur Warren, Santa Monica Police Department, to the effect 15 as follows. Investigator Warren told your affiant that on 17 March 28, 1540 hours, 1977, he was contacted at Santa Monica 31 Police Dept. by a 16 year old boy, regarding 19 slides (photographs) he had been shown which depicted sexual contact between young boys. 20 stated that the slides were shown to nim and his friend, 21 by a man known as Ralph, later identified as Kalph 22 slides were taken from photographs of young boys engaged 23 in oral copulation and analintercourse. 24 These slides were shown to 25 and home in Santa Monica on March 27, 1977. 26

On March 31, 1977 Investigator Warren contacted Ralph

told investigator Warren that he had obtained the slides from the home of Michael Ross, who ز then lived on Indiana Street in Venice. further stated that he had leased a garage from Ross and had helped 5 him move to the Indiana Street address. Bonnell stated that Ross had given him permission to use his house and that while was in Ross' home he observed the slides on the S correct table. Stated that he found the slides in August, 1976 and kept them after confronting Ross. 9 stated that he recognized part of the background and furnilû ture depicted in the slides as belonging to Michael Ross, 11 specifically pointed out a green room divider depicted 12 in the slides as belonging to Ross. I stated that Ross owns a considerable amount of photographic equipment including cameras and photo enlargers. On April 5, 1977 Raminary 1 gave the slides to Invιó estigators Warren and Wood, Santa Monica Police Dept. 17 Bonnell told investigators that Michael Ross keeps a black metal box in his residence which is locked with three pad-19 locks on each hasp. The box is approximately three feet by 20 two feet.in size. stated that Ross was very protect tive of the box and would not allow Bonnell to move or touch 22 the box. 23 Inv. Warren told your affiant that his investigaton 24 had revealed that Michael Ross is currently a Boy Scout 25 Leader In Santa Monica and in charge of Troop 222.

Inv. Marren Wald your amiliant that on April 7, 1977 he mad contacted a and his father. at their home in Santa Monica. was a member of Troop 12 in 1975 and Michael Ross was the Scout Leader. told Inv. Warren that he had first been contacted by Michael Ross in the spring of 1973 on the beach in Santa Monica. stated Michael Ross had taken pictures of him and his friends. further stated that a friend at Westminister School in Venice had told him Michael Ross was paying money to take pictures of ĨÜ boys in the nude during the spring of 1973. Inv. Warren 12 further identified this friend ac-On April 8, 13 1977 Inv. Warran contacted who is now fifteen years of age. told Inv. Warren that Michael 15 Rass had approached him and his brothers 13 yrs. ll yrs., on the Santa Monica beach by Pacific 16 Ocean Park in the fall of 1972. Michael Ross asked them if 17 they wanted to make some money. Michael Ross offered .6 and his two brothers three dollars each to let him take :9 their pictures. told Inv. Warren that he and his two brothers 2: 22 accompanied Ross to an apartment in Santa Monica where Ross took polaroid pictures of 23 and his brothers in the nude. told Inv. Warren that Michael Ross had toldhim that 24 25 taking photographs was his hobby. told Inv. Warren that he recalled seeing pictures ofnude menof all 26

further stated asus on the wells of House aparement. that bichael Ross had photographed him and his brothers on further stated that Michael three or four occasions. Ross had photographed him and his brothers individually and together in many different poses. 5 On April 22, 1977 at 1100 hours your affiant received 5 information from is an eleven year old boy who is now living at the Hathaway Home in Lake View Terrace. identity was discovered through a nude photograph seized pursuant to a Search Warrant issuell 10 by Judge Mary Waters issued in March 1977 against a person 11 suspected of crimes against children. told 12 your affiant that he used to be a Cub Scout and that Michael 15 Ross was a Boy Scout Leader. stated that he first met Michael Ross at a school in Santa Monica during a scout meeting around the beginning of summer, 1976. 16 17 informed your affiant that Michael Ross had taken him to numerous places during the time that he knew him. 18 places included Magic Mountain twice, to eat at different 9 restaurants, horseback riding, and to the movies. 20 stated Michael Ross had taken him to see the BAD NEWS BEARS 21 at Graumans Chinese Theater in Hollywood. 22 toldyour affiant that Michael Ross had "sucked his toes and 23 dick" (penis) a few times at Ross' house in Venice. 📑 told your affiant a thirteen year old, was present on the day that Michael Ross had sucked his toes.

tora your affiant that Michael Aoss had taken several photographs depicting him with his clothes on at a few of the different places they had gone to together. (See Attachment 4 B for complete crime report signed by Glen Besenty). 5 On April 55, 1977, at 1015 hours, your affiant received 6 information from a fourteen year old juvenile, 7 told your affiant that he first met Michael Ross 8 in the summer of 1976 at the Santa Monica Pier. 9 informed your affiant that Michael Ross had taken him to a 10 lot of places during the summer of 1976. These places 11 included boating and Magic Mountain twice. told 12 your affiant that Michael Ross had "sucked on his toes once i3 and on his dick (penis)" a couple of times during July and Aurust of 1976. told your affiant that 15 was present when Michael Ross sucked on his toes. 16 told your affiant that Michael Ross had taken : 7 several photographs of him with his clothes on at some of 18 the different places they had gone together. 19 informed your affiant that he overheard a heated argument 20 between a fat man named Ralph (possibly Ralph Bearland) and 21 Michael Ross. told your affiant that he heard 22 Ralph say, "Come on, Al (Ross' middle name), Who are you 23 trying to bullshit? You know you are on the run from New York for killing a seven year old" (See Attachment C for 25 Crime Report signed by told your affiant 26 that he did not hear Ross deny this allegation during the argument.

On April 26, 1977, your affiant received Santa Monica PoliceDept. report No. 73-6666, listing Michael ડૅ Allen Ross as a suspect. The Santa Monica Police Dept. report stated that in April 1973 Michael Allen Ross took 5 photographs depicting nudity of three young juveniles at his apartment in Santa Monica. (See Attachment D). Your affiant has found that in almost all of his invest tigations involving child molest and sexual exploitation that photographs and magazines have been used by the suspect 10 to entice, stimulate and arouse juvenile victims. The items 11 requested to be seized are items that are normally classi-12 fied as collector's items which are not traded and remain 13 in the custody of the person who originally obtained them. 14 The items have little commercial value and therefore the î 5 value is to the cwner in that he can build his collection ı6 and show them to others. Your affiant has been involved in 17 the arrest of individuals in possession of small amounts of 18 photographs and have found that these persons have been in possession of these items for long periods of time. afflant has found in other similar investigations of this nature that the suspects have the same habits and that their patterns of obtaining and seducing children are the same. ! Your affiant has found that the items requested to be seized are items which suspects refain, show and boast of to other 24 suspects of their conquests of the children involved. 26 Reference is made to Page 2, lines 16 and 17 of this
