Gentlemen:

Information concealed in this letter is strictly confidential and is not to be released to any court until further papers have been signed by releasing this information.

This is strictly to the Boy Scouts of America Office and no one else.

On three seperate occasions my Son, which is been sexually fondled by his scout master, Mr. Steve Beasley.

On the first occasion Mr. Beasley called my home asking permission for to go with him to Sky Mount to pick up some of his belongings and also to spend the night with him at his home. We thought this was alright so we agreed.

On this one occasion the only thing we did not agree with was that Beasley went swimming in the nude.

On the second occasion Mr. Beasley called my home, asking permission for to go to Chattanooga to see a movie and spend the night at his home.

On the third occasion Mr. Beasley called my home wanting to spend the night and learn to whittle. When spend the night. But , I , Myself, told nim that Mr. Beasley was lonesome and that he should stay.

I would pick him up. But when Mr. Beasley arrived he told would have to stay over night. Came back to the door crying and told me that Mr. Beasley said he would have to stay overnight and I told him to go ahead.

On the fourth occasion in a two week spand , Mr. Beasley called telling me that the Scouts were to park cars at a ballgame at South Pittsburg and that he would pick ap and then take him home with him to spend the night in order to go hunting early the next morning, which was Saturday August 28th.1976.

refused to ever spend the night with Mr. Beasley again and said he did not ever even want to see him again.

When my husband came home from work, I explained the situation to him, and he told me that there was not even a ballgame in South Pittsburg that night. He calls Mr. Beasley and told him there was no game, but Mr. Beasley said he would come and pick up anyway, so they could go bunting the following morning.

still refused to spend the night. My husband called Mr. Beasley again and told him he would take hunting himself .

did not know that my husband had called Mr. Beasley back the second time, and at 8:30 he came into our bedroom shaking and crying uncontrollably, and said, "Daddy I need to talk with you".

He then explained to his Dad that Mr. Beasley had sexually fondled him on 3 occasions late at night for a long period of time, until apparently Mr. Beasley got his satisfaction.

I went to patrol leader, that night about 9:00. We discussed this and she talked with and he said that Mr. Beasley had on occasion attempted fondling him by touching his legs and rear.

On August 28th, my Husband, and myself met at the Episcopal Church in the office of Dr. Jack Wilson, the minister of the church and also a psychiatist in South Pittsburg, and with District Attorney General of Marion County, Mr. Bill Killian

We told the facts to these men and Mr. Killian suggested that we take the matter to court.

I did not go to court because of the effects it would have on my child. I did not go to court because of the publicity.

We asked that the information we gave to Dr. Wilson and Mr. Killian be kept off record until further notice. Mr, Killian sent a TBI agent to Mr. Beasleys home and told him of the accusations, which he did not deny. He also told him of the conditions he would have to abide by if he stayed in the scouts.

This being that no child was to stay in his home over night alone, ever, and no less than 3 children on a camping trip.

It is our understanding that he is not abiding by this rule.

I have just finished a long conversation with Mr. Jim Hall and I am writing this letter to the Boy Scouts of America asking you to check into this situation and see that something is done, before he permanently damages a child.

I would like to leave you with the thought of , What if the next child is not afraid to speak up to Mr. Beasley and fights him off, or threatens to tell. What will Mr. Beasley do to that child. I feel if the manufacture of the swimming trips with Mr. Beasley that might not have made it home from some of his swimming trips with Mr. Beasley.

Thanking you in advance for your help in this urgent matter and asking you to take immediate action and advise us accordingly, we remain
