


Thank you for your letter of February 5, and the attached newspaper clipping concerning Arthur H. Downing. We have placed this information in our file.

JAILED - A man who faces three sodomy charges in Whatcom County Superior Court has been given a 90 day jail sentence in district court for the possession of marijuana. The sentence was meted out by Judge Leslie

Lee after Art Downing, 38, 437 D St., Blaine, pleaded innocent to charge.

An appeal bond of \$300 was established after Downing indicated he intended to appeal the decision.

APPEALS DECISION-Arthur Howard Downing, 38, 437 D St., has appealed a Nov. 4 decision in Whatcom County District court finding him guilty of possession of marijuana. Judge Leslie A. Les sentenced him to 90 days in jail.

An appeal bond of \$300 has been established.

TO BE EXAMINED-A man ac-

cused of sodomy will receive a thorough psychiatric examination at Western State Hospital.

Arthur Howard Downing, 38, Blaine, and his attorney waived the requirement that two local psychiatrists make an examination prior to such action being taken. to such action being taken.

Judge Swedberg refused to order a similar procedure for Joel Peter Kelper, 19, 1714 12th St., charged with indecent exposure. On Nov. 27, a jury was unable to reach a verdict in his

Judge Swedberg told Deputy Prosestating the reasons why an examination for possible sexual psychopathy is warranted. The matter will be considered again in two wceks.

Arthur Howard Downing, 38, 437 D St., Blaine, pleaded guilty to two counts of sodomy. His sentencing was postponed until the results of an ex-
