

This is the report of experience with Mr. Kenneth Hall that you requested. Please excuse our seeming tardiness. But it has been a difficult thing for all of us to do. First, we have had strong emotional reactions to control after learning what happened. Secondly, we wanted to be sure we gave you as detailed a report as possible. Finally, it has been difficult for my wife and I to get together to be certain of dates and actions that were taken. The has searched his mind to try to remember what was said on each occasion. It has been an unpleasant experience for him. We has said he will be very glad when it is over.

Tuesday evening. February 3, 1976. By wife and I met with and some other parents for a meeting concerning the affairs of Troop 381. At this meeting told us he needed a boy to speak on the topic, "What Scouting Means to Me", at a Lion's Club dinner honoroing the Westminster Roy Scouts. My wife and I volunteered services because we knew would enjoy this experience. We is articulate, has had a summer school session in drams, and works with his church youth group whenever they give special performances or services for our church.

Thursday evening, February 5, 1976.

Lion's Club Dinner at Frock's Banquet Wall. Before the dinner was approached by Mr. Kenneth Wall. Mr. Hall asked if he would be willing to demonstrate winter camping to other Boy Scout troops. He told that there were many troops that did no winter camping. It told him that he would be willing, but he would have to check with his parents first. After the dinner Mr. Wall talked to again. We told him that he would give him a call to set up an appointment.

Mr. Hall called later, but we do not know the date of this call. He made an appointment to take to lunch on Monday. Pebruary 16th, one of the days the Carroll County schools were closed. He told to dress as he would to go winter camping and to have his back pack and sleeping bag ready with the items he would take for winter camping.

After checking with his mother, agreed.

Monday afternoon, February 16, 1976. Er. Wall came to our house to take to lunch at Jino's on Route 140. was dressed in Scout clothing suitable for winter camping and had his back pack and sleeping bag ready. They went to Jino's for lunch. Then they went to Er. Wall's apartment at 111 Shaeffer Avenue.

At his apartment Mr. Fall told what he wanted him to do. He wanted him to remove each item of clothing and explain why it was worn. When he had removed all of his clothing he was to get his sleeping bag ready before he put on his pajamas or other clothing. explained that he had not brought pajamas with him but he did have a change of clothing. Er. Hall told to relax and take his time about putting on a change of clothing. He told him he should take care of his sleeping bag first. He explained that this would emphasize the importance of giving the body perspiration time to evaporate before putting on fresh clothing. Mr. Hall also told that a boy who had done this demonstration earlier had been embarrassed when a young scout had touched him when he was undressed. He said that boy had pretended not to notice and proceeded with the demonstration. He told that he would be touching him to see if his voice cracked and to see how he would react. Fe explained to that he would also need five pictures of him in the nude. These would be of his front, back, each side, and one of an erection. Fe said he would have to take these later because he had loaned his camera to a friend. He said that he needed these pictures to determine which boys would be best suited for doing these demonstrations before Scouts of different ages. told me later that this seemed strange to him, but he believed that and Mr. Bloom knew about this so it must be all right.

removed his scout uniform item by item and explained the reason for wearing each item as if he were demonstrating this to a group of young scouts. Then he was nude he took his sleaping bag off his pack and unrolled it, explaining what type of bag it was, what kind of material it was made of, and why it was comfortable. Finally, put on the change of clothing he had in his pack. put on the change of clothing he had in his pack. Mr. Hall told that he had done everything right but that he had moved too fast. we told him to go slower, especially to go slow to emphasize giving the body perspiration time to evaporate. repeated the demonstration again. While was nude, just after he had rolled out his sleeping bag and stood up to remove his scout uniform from his pack, Mr. Fall fondled his buttocks with his hand. Then he fondled his penis and his testicles with his hand. When complained that this tickled, Mr. Hall told him not to think about the tickling. Then told him that he could not think of anything else to say. Mr. Wall told him to try to think of something else to say. When Mr. Wall took his hand away got back into his uniform. Mr. Wall told that he had done Okay. That he had done good. That was all he needed him for. We told that he would see if he could get him lined up for a demonstration. We told him that he would take the pictures when he got his camera back. Then he took him home.

Mr. Hall called again but we do not know the date of this call. He made arragnements with to take him to a scout troop in the Hampstead area for a demonstration.

Wednesday afternoon. March 3, 1976. After our supper Mr. Hall picked up to take him to the Tampstead area to give a demonstration. The remembers Mr. Hall missing a turn and turning his car around in the old Morth Carroll High School parking lot. On the way Mr. Hall told that the first demonstration was the hardest one. That after that they were easier. He took to a church but does not remember the name of it.

At the meeting gave the demonstration as he had rehearsed it for approximately ten boys. The boys were seated about fifteen feet away from Hr. Wall and the troop Gooutmaster stood in the back of the room. The recognized one of the boys, as a member of one of his Sunday School classes two years earlier.

the Carroll Plaza Shopping Center to get film for his camera. Then he took him to his apartment to take the five pictures. We told there would be time between each picture because it took time for them to develop. He said they had to check each picture to be sure it was right. Undressed and Hr. Wall took pictures of his sides, front and his back. Saw only the pictures of his side. They were pictures of him from the neck down. Then Hr. Wall told he wanted a picture of an erection. Untold him that was impossible. We told him that he had taken Phys. Ed. and showers with boys and that he shared a room with his brother. We said he could not get an erection like that. Mr. Hall suggested some pictures might help. I looked at four pictres he handed him briefly, then put them down. We described them as being fuzzy pictures. We remembers only one clearly. It was of a man or a woman, he could not be sure, with a mouth over a penis.

The TV was on because had asked if he could watch the new Bionic Woman show. Hr. wall suggested that could wait until the show was over, but got dressed and asked Hr. wall to take him home.

Then got home I was asleep on my sofa. I had been trying to overcome the effects of a cold. Woke me when he spoke harshly to his older sisters. I told him to go to bed. Later that night he talked to his mother about the pictures. Before I went to work the next morning my wife told me I should talk to to see what was going on with Er. Hall. When I talked to he told me only about the four pictures that were taken. I resolved to check it out with the but my work and other family problems delayed or side tracked me.

Monday night, March 15, 1976. After Scout meeting he showed me an impressive looking framed certificate Mr. wall had given him at the meeting for Winter Camping Demonstrations. He also showed me a \$25 Savings Bond in his name that Mr. wall had given him. Mr. wall had asked Mr. Rush's permission to present with a special award before the other boys of his troop. Mr. Rush had agreed. Mr. Halls had used words commending for doing a good job. But he had also said that he was going to use to train other boys for Winter Camping Demonstrations. I told that he was not going to give any more demonstrations for Mr. Hall.

Tuesday night, March 16, 1975. I called to talk to him about Mr. Hall's Finter Camping Demonatrations. I still knew very little about it. I decided I wanted to hear it at the same time I did. I was hoping he could put my mind at ease by verifying Mr. Tall's activities as being a part of the Carroll County Scouting program. Could not do this. The listened to briefly. Then he for a writing pad and began taking notes. Before our meeting was over I had learned many of the details I have noted in this report.

Thursday night, March 18, 1976. Called to ask us to meet with him and Mr. Bloom. At this meeting most of the details of this report were revealed. I had forgotten to bring the framed certificate and Savings Bond. While I drove home to get them for Mr. Bloom told of the most intimate and embarrassing things that had happened. Since then, he has gradually told me the entire story as best as he can remember it.

Ken Hall first called me on Sunday. March 14th to ask if he could make a presentation to Scout helping him put on a winter camping demonstration. I agreed.

Monday night, March 15th, Ken Hall came to our Junior Troop meeting and made a short speech telling us what a good job had done with a winter camping demonstration. Hall indicated in his remarks that the award was coming from our new Carroll District. I was at the opposite end of the room when Ken handed a framed certificate and a second piece of paper to later turned out to be a Savings Bond.) Ken told that this was also in appreciation and Hall eluded to the fact that this also came from, or thru, our new Carroll District.

Tuedday night, March 16th, called me at my home and wanted to know if he and his son, could come to my home to discuss winter camping demonstrations. I agreed.

After the first few minutes of social conversation it was apparent to me that was upset about something when he asked, "How far are these demonstrations supposed (or expected) to go?"

I asked him what he meant.

wanted to know if it was part of our Scouting program for a boy to strip completely naked to give an acceptable demonstration. I told that it was never done and such a demonstration served no useful purpose.

After this I asked to detail the demonstration that

he had been working with for Ken Hall.

related how he had gone to Hall's residence on a day off from school (probably Washington's birthday) equipped with all the personal gear a Scout would take on a Winter camping trip. Hall told him that he wanted him to practice in front of him so he would know what to do when he ran through it in front of a Scout troop audience.

said that he did this twice. Both times he did strip completely naked as if preparing for bed. The second time told me Hall touched his genitals. Halls explanation to was that another boy previous to this had been embarrased when another boy in the viewing group reached up and touched him causing the demonstrator to have an erection while in front of the group.

At an evening meeting went through the complete demonstration for a Scout troop in Manchester of Hampstead Md. (T-448) Ken Hall, about ten Scouts and the Scoutmaster were present then. stripped naked before the group but nothing else happened

there at that time according to
On the way back home told us Hall stopped at Drug
Fair to buy a roll of Polaroid film since his other camera was
out on loan and had not been returned.

Back at Hall's residence was asked to pose for a series of nude phtographs taken from his chest down. Hall told him this was to determine if the belonged with an older group of boys or with a younger group. Said four pictures were taken by Hall--two from the front and one from each side. For a fifth picture Hall then requested that try to achieve an erection. Total told us that at this point he told Hall the whole thing embarrassed him and he could not do it.

This is the story as related to and me on Tuesday. March 16th.

After I assured that I would look into the whole matter at once and take some action they both left my home. I got in touch with Reed Blom by phone at about 10:45 P.M.

that same night and he immediately came to my home as I requested where I re-told the story as given above.

On Wednesday evening, March 17th, his son

and Reed Blom met with me at my home.

At this time re-told the story essentially as I have put it down here. This is where I found other information that a Savings bond was included in the presentation. At the same time told how in the picture taking session Hall had suggessted that maybe if had some porno pictures to view he had available might then be quickly aroused to have an erection.

spoke about some porno pictures that had been torn out of a magazine showing he said; A couple of guys together. He did not elaborate.

also told the three of us that Hall had handled his genitals to see if he could arouse him enough to have an erection. Later the same evening returned the certificate

and the bond to Reed Blom for what ever use he wanted them. These are the details as I can best remember them on Wednesday, March 31, 1976. To the best of my knowledge I have related all the details of this happening here.
