He was attempting registration earlier in 1987, but we immediately wrote you a letter in May, indicating that we had received this registration and that we wanted you to check and determine if it was the same individual. A few days later, we did have a telephone conversation with your office and it was indicated that it was the same person. You sent a suspension letter to the individual on May 21, 1987. We suspended all of his registration in this office at that time also.

If you have any further information which you feel we should have in our file at this time, please do not hesitate to send it. In the meantime, we feel we have enough to refuse registration anywhere Mr. Brewer might locate.

Listed below is information on four individuals, incidents and brief report attached. Please review and call me back with your recommendations for follow up action.

*Emil Vitolo - He was arrested, charged and convicted. (Report #1)

*<u>John Varille</u> - He was accused and admitted giving a six pack of beer to a sixteen year old staff person at summer camp.

*John Brewer - He was suspended from Scouting several years ago. He was re-registered with the Boy Scout troop. Later he went on a camping of trip to the Sierra Mountains out west without council knowledge but with the sponsor's knowledge and endorsement.

*George Magdich - He served as Camp Tamarack Director and is a school teacher. In 1985, there were several rumors floating around about his behavior with Boy Scouts. The police department was involved but had difficulty securing cooperation from "alleged" victims, parents and witnesses and consequently no charges were filed. He has remained in Scouting.

Paul, in the event I am not in when you call back, please feel free to discuss with Field Director, Ed Rasmuson.

Dear Mr. Brewer:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. Therefore we are compelled to require that you sever any and all relationship that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. This decision is based on a confidential file of March 1976.

You should understand that Boy Scouts of America leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential. However, the sponsoring organizations and the Scouting Coordinators of the units you are involved in will be notified of your suspended registration.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scouts of America leader should be reinstated.


Dear Chief Mitchell:

On Monday, January 19, 1976, District Scout Amecutive Steven J. Gerber received a phone call from Chief David Mitchell of the Wyckoff, New Jersey Police asking if he could meet with Chief Mitchell. Later that day at a meeting, Chief Mitchell emplained that during the course of the previous evening a member of Post 139 had been apprehended. In the morning, while being questioned by the police, while in the presence of his father, the young man related how he had been paid \$25 - \$30 by John Brewer on each of several occasions to engage in sexual acts.

Prior to this occurance, the Myckoff police had received several unsubstantiated reports.

Following the meeting with Chief Mitchell, Steve Gerber related the details to his Field Director, Lee Vigue, and the Emploring Director, Brian Archimbaud, under whose jurisdiction this volunteer functioned. Brian Archimbaud proceeded to contact Mr. Brewer and arranged a meeting at the Council office for Monday, January 26, 1976, where, with Steve Gerber present as a vitness, Mr. Brewer was confronted with the information supplied by Chief Mitchell. Mis reaction was singular and immediate. He admitted to the behavior alleged to him and-offered to resign immediately.

On January 29, 1976 we received a copy of a resignation statement (attached) from Mr. Brewer.
