The President called Done son in to meet with the three of us. He asked Donelson to resign and told him why. didn't have to use the carcumstantial evidence assembled from the interviews nor the signed statement. Donelson resigned immediately without discussion or argument.

He did not call me previously because he didn't know just what to do. said the situation finally bothered him so much that he fell he had to call me for advice. 

Brendy's October 24 report on Council 635 concerning Scout Executive, F. Dwight Donelson, is in my wands as I write this letter to you. At the end of the report, under recommendations made, not only does he make the statement that Donelson should not be re-employed but that he should be placed on C.I.L.. We assume he means the confidential file, and this is the purpose of writing.
