



I am committee chairman of Troop 6, Cincinnati, Ohio. On July 4, 1984, while wisiting my son at BSA camp Hook, Carlisle, Ohio (operated by Moundaulders Council), I was given some disturbing information concerning Richard J. Gruber, our present scoutmaster.

Tom Scott, camp director, (I understand that he is a paid scout official) and Roger Brummett, program director, told me that approximately 24 years and Mr. Gluber was caught engaging to a homosexual activity ith a scout executive. Mr. Scott told me that he had been authorized by his superior (not identified) to relay this information to me in my capacity as committee chairman. I lacked Missirs. Scott and Brummett for verification of this incident. They bold me that they personally had none except to the extent that they personally had none except to the extent that they received the information for the situation with Mr. Gruber and that his fully was east to be situation with Mr. Gruber and that his table was one list of understrables.

Mr. Scott was quite emphatic in his concern for the safety of our boys based on Mr. Gruber's background. Accordingly, in order that the committee may make a reasoned, informed judgment regarding Mr. Gruber, I am formally requesting that National headquarters with any and all information that you may have concerning Mr. Gruber. Furthermore, I am asking that you direct your local scout executive to provide any and all information he may have concerning Mr. Grubes.

Finally, I bring to your attention that Mr. Gruber is registered with the scout organization. Thus, if the information given to me by Messrs. Scott and Brummett is correct, I wild like an explanation as to why it has not been provided to the troop committee before now.







Please let me know if you need other help from us concerning this matter.


