Guilty Plea

Kenneth Norris Knutson, 42, of Santa Barbara, pleaded guilty in Superior Court yesterday to two counts of sexual perversion, and the district attorney's office moved to have him certificated as a mentally disordered sex offender.

Knutson admitted two sexual acts with a minor girl. On the motion of the district attorney, nine other counts of morals offenses were dismissed.

Judge C. Douglas Smith ordered Knutson held in the county jail and appointed three psychiatrists to examine him. He had been indicted by the grand jury last month.

Man Arraigned In the Rape of 2 Minor Girls

Kenneth Norman Knutson, 42, was arraigned in Superior Court today on a grand jury indictment charging him with 10 counts of rape, fornication and sexual perversion involving two minor girls.

Knutson, a private investigator, who made an unsuccessful bid to enter the sheriff's race against Sheriff James W. Webster in 1966, appeared today before Judge C. Douglas Smith. The arraignment was continued until next Monday at 10 a.m.

HELD IN JAIL

Knutson is held in the county jail in lieu of \$12,500 bail, set by the grand jury during a secret hearing last Thursday.

Two sheriff's detectives, Glenn Williams and John A. Hunter, arrested Knutson at his home at 4619 Chalon Way about 3:45 p.m. Friday. The indictment and arrest were not made public until Knutson appeared in court. John Barnes, a local attorney, appeared with Knutson on behalf of Edward Stanton, who will represent him in future proceedings.

GIRLS 12, 16

The indictment charges Knutson with statutory rape, lewd and lascivious conduct, fornication and adultery between March 30, 1966, and Feb. 10, 1968. The girls involved are aged 12 and 16, officers said.

Knutson was forced to give up his plans to run for sheriff when he filed his nomination papers with the county clerk 12 minutes late in March, 1966.
