The letter you enclosed from Mr. Ames of the University of Florida is most interesting. With the evidence as submitted, it will be most difficult in years to come to make decisions about the registration of Mr. Hladke. About the only thing we have been able to do when we lack concrete evidence in old cases on the file, is to write the council that the man had been in trouble which didn't seem to be of a very serious matter. After the council was informed of the facts, we would register a man if they ask us to do so.

Since the only information you have given us on Mr. Hladke is so scanty, about the only thing we can do is to place him on the Confidential File as a precautionary measure. Then should he move to another council, we would at least be in the position to inform the Scout Executive of his past history.

Dear Horace:

In reply to your letter of the twenty-seventh, in regard to Mr. Hladke, it is with regret that I must report to you that he was dismissed from employment at the University of Florida for tampering with the mail and is not eligible for reemployment with this institution.

The nature of his offense consisted primarily in removing foreign postage from incoming mail, and replacing the removed stamps with postage due stamps. This meant the University was losing various amounts in Due Postage as these thefts occurred, plus the delay in the mail reaching the addressee. This may have been done with the best of intentions, perhaps that of accumulating foreign stamps to help some Scouts with their stamp collections. We do not know for sure whether he made money by selling the stamps, or whether he was giving them away.
