

REPORT FROM WARREN J. MERRITT  
 Westwood District Executive

ON - -TERRENCE DANIEL LAYMAN  
 Scoutmaster, Troop 218

The District Commissioner, Al Shipman was notified by the mother of a former Scout of this troop that Torrence D. Layman, then Scoutmaster had solicited and then engaged in homosexual acts with her son. She told him that she first became suspicious when a younger son complained that this Scoutmaster fondled and kissed him whenever they were alone. She then questioned her older boy who confessed and named another boy also involved. Mr. Shipman called upon the second boy who confessed to having engaged in homosexual acts with this Scoutmaster. At a meeting of a few key men from the Committee it was discovered that on campouts this Scoutmaster insisted on sleeping apart from the rest of the troop with another young man, usually the Assistant Scoutmaster. On reviewing all the testimony the Troop Committee felt that this information, along with other actions they had observed, warranted the immediate selection of a replacement for the Scoutmaster.
