Several of these boys involved were sons of committee members. Complete investigation on our part seemed to substantiate all of these. The Scoutmaster was confronted with the charges at a special meeting of the committee with D.S.E. Goehring and Commissioner Gottschalk present. After hearing these charges Mr. Reynolds resigned at once.

This additional information will enable us to identify Mr. Reynolds should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Many thanks for your kind cooperation.

In order for the unit to continue to receive program inserts in Scouting Magazine, it will be necessary to advise this office of the name of the new unit leader. This should be done by filing with us an additional enrollment for this individual in his new position. Please do not file a separation notice as we have already dropped the current leader.

Yesterday a delegation of three members of the Troop 401, Medford committee visited me in regard to their Scoutmaster, Charles E. Reynolds.

According to their testimony at least four members of the troop have been involved in immoral acts with the Scoutmaster. At our suggestion the Troop Committee met with him last evening, with our District Executive, Richard Goehring in attendance. After being confronted with the facts by the Troop Committee, Mr. Reynolds offered his resignation and turned over all records of the Troop to the Committee along with his registration cards.

Thus he is no longer Scoutmaster and it is our considered opinion that he be placed on the confidential file.
