
Dear Mr. Holt:

Dear Mr. Krall:

You received correspondence from us on October 30, 1969 concerning Bernard Colie Atkinson, Sr. and requested he be placed on the confidential file with the Boy Scouts of America.

You wrote us on November 13, 1969 advising that steps were being taken to delete him from the roster of Pack 67 of our council and requested additional information.

Enclosed is the confidential record sheet on Mr. Atkinson with accompanying record of indictment for child molestation.

We also wish to request that Mr. C. E. Nunnally be placed on the confidential file of the Boy Scouts of America. It is very possible that he is already on this file. Mr. Nunnally is not and has not, as far as we know, been registered in Scouting in the Tukabatchee Area Council. However, he has often represented himself as a Scout leader in getting boys together for outings and there has been considerable concern that homosexuality activities were involved. Mr. Nunnally was not a registered Scouter and neither were the boys. However, parents of these boys were lead to believe that Mr. Nunnally represented the Boy Scouts of America. He has been watched closely for three or four years. Local law enforcement officers have even discussed with us the possibility of bringing charges of impersonation but sufficient proof was never obtained.

He was recently caught, arrested and charged with child molestation and the record of indictment for this charge is enclosed.

Mr. Nunnally was active in Scouting several years ago in the Tuscaloosa, Alabama Council and did have an undesirable reputation in that council. He may be on the confidential file of the Boy Scouts of America. If not, we believe this action whould be taken since there is a practice on his part to tell people he is a Scout leader and could possibly attempt to register with the Boy Scouts of America.

Please forgive the delay in forwarding these materials. They have been difficult to obtain, as you well know.


