

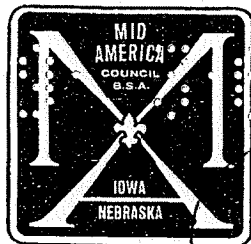

Hoping that this is the type of information you need to substantiate your refusing Mr. Austin in attempt to register him in the Scouting program.

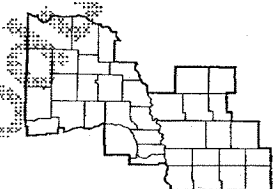



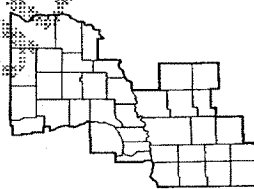
