

Reference is made to your inquiry of 25 September 1969 and your request for a copy of the voluntary statement made by Bradford, after his arrest for Public Lewdness on 24 September 1969.

Thomas W. Bradford, 18 Birchgrove Drive, Central Islip, age 22, did make a voluntary statement admitting to repeated acts of public lewdness.
