Thank you for your confidential record sheets concerning Matthew Joseph Harford, registered as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 8 and William Burton Ewell, currently registered as Scoutmaster of Troop 237. We have placed this information in our files and have taken steps to have their names deleted from the respective unit rosters.

Although we have sufficient identification particulars, we would very much appreciate your forwarding to us any substantiating documents that might be available pertaining to each of these situations, such as copy of police record; copy of court record; statement from any of the boys involved or from the boys' parents; any newspaper clippings, etc.. Thanks for your help.
