Dear Sir:

Gerald Thomas Armstrong was charged in this city of the crimes, Attempted Sodomy and Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, 5-12-60.

Prior to subject's arrest, we had received rumors and mild complaints from parents and other parties, of his keen interest in very young boys. Armstrong had started several types of activities and clubs and the members were generally in the 11 to 15 years group.

At date of trial, the District Attorney informed us that two of the witnesses had moved to the states and it would prove too costly to return them to Ketchikan. The District Attorney asked for dismissal on both charges, due to lack of evidence.

After Armstrong's release from jail here, he immediately married a local girl and tried to resume his youth activities, but indignant parents prevented their children from associating with him.

We have been unable to locate past criminal history on this subject.

CARDITIONAL OSTATUS OF OFTENSE, PRINCES OF INCO

JANUARY 24, 1961:

MRS. WFA, reported to OFFICER DON MULKEY that she wented to telk to the Investigation Division concerning GERALD THOMAS ARMSTRONG. She told MULKEY that ARMSTRONG was licking-up her 15 year old boy send taking him to school. She wented to check the man for character. MRS. made her including at 1630 hours. I tried to contact her in the evening, but she had left her residence at #210 FRANKLIN HOTEL.

JANUARY 25, 1961:

I arranged with the CAPITOL SCHOOL (Eighth Grade) to have come to the Station after school to talk to SCT. CECIL RASLER shares. We questioned about the actions of ARMSTRONG with negative results. MIKE's comments about ARMSTRONG indicated that his behavior toward him ( ) has not been reducibly different from that to other boys. ARMSTRONG works on a construction crew which is building houses somewhere, according to MIKE. ARMSTRONG gives MIKE rides when he should happen to see him welking to school. It is not a pre-erranged thing.

JANUARY 26, 1961:

FIO SMITH called me at the station to incurre about GERALD T. ARMSTRONG. She had heard about him in Katchikan. I told her I had heard similar rumors but that there is not any record of conviction of proof of substantiation existent for reference. She said that had offers from analyzerond to stay the night with him on at least one occasion, and has had offers to dome over to ARMSTRONG'S for dinner. I requested that if she learns of any definite violation of law by the subject, that she contect this Department immediately. She was most willing to cooperate to this end. A T.A 1-24-4

JANUARY 30, 1961: A letter to the Ketchiken Police Department was drafted concerning a possible connection between GERAID T. ARMSTRONG and the sex-essociated burglaries in the FOSBEE AFARTMENTS. [See correspondence.] Regative - not burglaries

NOTE: On December 2, 1960 CHIEF t. L. SEVERSON took up the findings of this investigati as then existent with FATHER MELBOURNE at the Catholic School where GERALD ARMSTRONG had spearheaded a youth activity program. Since that program's inception, ARMSTRONG has bee under observation. TACK MOULIN, street foreman for LORD BROS. CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, gave me the initial tip that ARMSTRONG had been "kicked out of Katchikan" for deviant sexual behavior. MOULIN lived in Katchikan prior to moving to Juneau last year.

FEBRUARY 28, 1961: To date I have observed ARMSTRONG in the company of several small boys during the early evening hours. ARMSTRONG incressantly drives around the Channel Area in a pick-up truck of his own or a firm vehicle, also a pick-up truck. Sometimes he has the wife with him and a few small boys. More often, however, I have observed ARMSTRONG alone with a small boy or a couple of them. These boys are known to me by sight as members of the Youth Program under ARMSTRONG'S supervision.


