STATEMENT OF [REDACTED], POST 194, CINCINNATI, OHIO

In the interest of the Boy Scouts of America, my Advisor, and the boys of our Post 194, I hereby submit the following statement regarding Kenneth Cordes.

Several months ago Ken Cordes invited myself and four other boys to spend the weekend at the "Castle" in Loveland. When I got up in the morning I looked to see if Ken Cordes was up and I found him at the top of the Castle where he was sleeping with a boy named [REDACTED] (This is the boy who received publicity in the local newspapers regarding an episode at the Castle where he ran away). When I walked into the area where they were sleeping the night before, both Ken Cordes and [REDACTED] were laying flat on their backs and Ken was "jerking" [REDACTED] off. Ken was completely nude which was the way he always slept. [REDACTED] had his underwear on and Ken had his hand inside. In my association with Ken Cordes he always slept in the nude and always went swimming in the nude.

I have no personal knowledge of any boy in our Post ever having any type of an "affair" with Ken Cordes. To the best of my knowledge he never approached any of my friends and he never made any passes or gestures toward me.

I have been in contact with many boys who knew Ken and they always kidded about the fact that they "suspected" that Ken was queer. The only boy that he ever slept with, including camp outs, was [REDACTED]. One weekend our Post was camping at Sunrise lake and Ken was supposed to help. He did not join with our Advisor and the other adults until the morning after the first night when he came to the camp about 10 AM with [REDACTED].

I haven't been in Ken Cordes' company in the past year. He has not participated in any of our Post activities for more than a year.

I give this statement of my own free will and accord to be used as a CONFIDENTIAL file for the Boy Scouts of America, and for no other purpose.

I am enclosing for your records the resignation of Mr. Kenneth M. Cordes. He has worked his way into a number of units in this council and I think I have the complete list:

- Troop 183 - Assistant Scoutmaster
- Pack 690 - Assistant Cubmaster
- Post 194 & Post 50 - Associate Advisor
- Troop 149 - Scoutmaster

We request that he be placed on the confidential file but at this moment I do not have any supporting statements. Most everything is by word of mouth but there is promise. We did uncover enough, however, that we can no longer take the risk of continuing his Scouting affiliation. I had a session with him last night, of course, following our regular procedure of making no charges, but he told me why he thought we were taking this action and, of course, denied it. Through private sources I have found that his records of employment show at least one dismissal where homosexual tendencies were made a part of his record.

I believe that we will come up with something definite and concrete for you within a few days but in the meantime will you please delete his name from the records of the above units.

Incidentally, I hope we do not have a rash of these things but you can save us a little time and yourself some postage if you will send us about a dozen of the confidential record sheets.

Hope all is well with you.
