Dear Skipper,

It is my sad duty to place William D. Heppburn, Scoutmaster of Troop 14, Lexington, Ky, on the confidential list.

He is an electrical contractor...once lived in Florida...holds the Silver Beaver...has been considered one of our better leaders.

I sat yesterday with three members of the Troop Committee, all doctors, all had sons involved; and the minister of the church, and heard Bill admit to the charges.

It seems that this is a rather recent development, not over 3 years back. This was born out by two of the doctors who had questioned older brothers who had previously belonged to the unit and who stated that they had never known anything out of the way going on.

Every effort is being made to keep this quiet, although if Mr. Heppburn does not leave town within 90 days the parents are prepared to prosecute. They did allow him 90 days in order to close out his business--which is grossing over 100,000 dollars business a year. He is not to talk to any of the boys in this period, or in anyway contact them under penalty of being held to court.
