

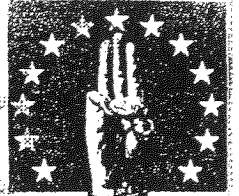

Dear George:

We have received the application of Mr. O'Callaghan for Neighborhood Commissioner. I am very sorry, but we cannot register him and it will be necessary for you to tell him that the National Council refuses to register him. We suggest that you do this in person and through no one else. We also request that you make no mention of the Confidential File, but simply tell him that since he cannot be registered, he cannot have anything to do with Scouting. We have no desire to embarrass him, and this will give him a chance to make up any excuses he may desire in order to withdraw gracefully.

If he should ask why, and he probably will, your best answer is that you do not know. This is why we do not tell you the reason we refuse registration. We make no charges, but simply say that we do not wish to register him.

The refund of his registration fee will follow in a few days.

Dear Colonel Latson:

Mr. Leed has joined the Valley Forge Council as Assistant to the Scout Executive and his replacement has not yet reported for duty. Until our new Assistant Director of Registration arrives, I am handling correspondence for the Direct Service.

The letter from Major Collinson with your endorsement brings disturbing news, but we do appreciate your thoughtfulness in notifying us. As you can well imagine, we can take steps to see that Airman O'Callaghan is not registered with the Boy Scouts of America in the future.

It is almost useless to list his name unless we have some means of identifying him, should he attempt to register. We use the enclosed confidential record sheet for this purpose. Will you please have it filled out for us. If you have his home address in the states, it will be most helpful.

While the letter from Major Collinson is sufficient, it will be most helpful for those who may sit in this position in years to come if you could give us a little bit more information. I am not familiar with Air Force Regulation 35-66 and sometimes assumptions are dangerous. A simple statement from those concerned concerning events that led up to this action will be most appreciative. You can assure those who make such statements that they are kept in the permanent file of the Boy Scouts of America, under lock and key, and are shared with no one.

We will delete his name from the unit application.


