Dear Mr. Verneuy:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 4 concerning your registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

You indicate that your name has been misspelled by us. I note your letter clearly indicates your name as Verneuy, but I also have in my hands a handwritten application for adult registration in the Boy Scouts of America, in your own handwriting which very clearly indicates the spelling of your name to be Verney, both in its printed place and in its signature location on the application. Could it be that when you applied for registration in Pack 254 you mistakenly spelled your name Vernelly and then when applying in Pack 296 you spelled it Verney and now you indicate it should be Verneuy. If we have made an error I express our regrets but, in view of what you personally wrote on your latest application, I find it difficult to assume responsibility for an error on this point.

Mr. Don Johnson was correct in the information he provided you concerning your recent application for registration. As you know, because of your past association in Scouting dating back to the time when you served as Assistant Cubmaster of Pack 111 at the Naha Air Force Base in Okinawa while you were with the Air Force prior to your leaving Okinawa in June 1964, the Boy Scouts of America is primarily concerned in inculcating its objectives of character development and citizenship training in the lives of youth.

In keeping with these objectives, the Scouting organization has always reserved the prerogative of accepting applications from those individuals it feels are best qualified to give the kind of leadership that this organization wishes for boys enrolled in the Scouting program.

Occasionally, the Boy Scouts of America decides that, in its best judgment, it is unwilling to accept an application to commission an individual for a leadership role. Whenever it makes this decision, it gives no reasons for this action and this is never intended as a criticism or accusation of any type.

On behalf of the Boy Scouts of America, I regret to advise you that at the present time we are unwilling to accept your registration as a leader of boys in the Scouting program.

AFTER HAVING REGISTERED AS ADULT CUB SCOUT LEADER WITH CUB SCOUT PACK #254, VALLEY STREAM, N.Y., FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR, '56-'57, I FOUND IT NECESSARY TO RE-NEW MY MEMBERSHIP WITH ANOTHER CUB SCOUT PACK WHICH IS CUB SCOUT PACK #296 OF VALLEY STREAM, N.Y. BECAUSE IT IS LOCATED CLOSER TO ME FOR MY CONVENIENCE. MY SERVICES AS AN ADULT CUB SCOUT LEADER WERE NO LONGER REQUIRED BY CUB SCOUT PACK #254.

I APPLIED FOR RE-NEWAL AS AN ADULT CUB SCOUT LEADER WITH CUB SCOUT PACK #296 AS AN ADULT LEADER PRIOR TO DEC. 31, 1967 WHICH WAS WHEN MY PREVIOUS REGISTRATION WAS INVALID, AND HAVEN'T RECEIVED WORD ABOUT MY NEW APPLICATION UNTIL THE OTHER DAY. WHEN A MR. DON JOHNSON FROM NASSAU COUNTY COUNCIL, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, ROSLYN, NEW YORK, INFORMED ME THAT MY APPLICATION WAS REFUSED BY YOUR OFFICE IN NEW JERSEY.

I AM ENCLOSING THE COVER FROM THE FEBRUARY 1968 ISSUE OF SCOUTING MAGAZINE, OF WHICH I STILL RECEIVE AND YOU WILL NOTE, ACCORDING TO IT, THAT I WAS REGISTERED AND, MUST STILL BE REGISTERED WITH MY OLD CUB PACK, HOWEVER THIS CANNOT BE ACCORDING TO THEIR NEW CHARTER. YOU WILL ALSO NOTE THAT MY LAST NAME IS MISPELLED. I WOULD APPRECIATE IT IF SOMEONE IN YOUR OFFICE WOULD LET ME KNOW WHY MY APPLICATION FOR RE-NEWAL AS AN ADULT CUB SCOUT LEADER WITH CUB SCOUT PACK #296 WAS REFUSED BY YOUR OFFICE, OR WHAT THE PROBLEM WITH THE APPLICATION MAY BE.

I WOULD LIKE TO RE-NEW MY MEMBERSHIP AS AN ADULT CUB SCOUT LEADER WITH CUB SCOUT PACK #296, AND WOULD BE MORE THAN WILLING TO FILL OUT A NEW APPLICATION IF YOUR OFFICE WOULD BE KIND ENOUGH TO SEND ONE TO ME. THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR YOUR HELP IN THIS MATTER.

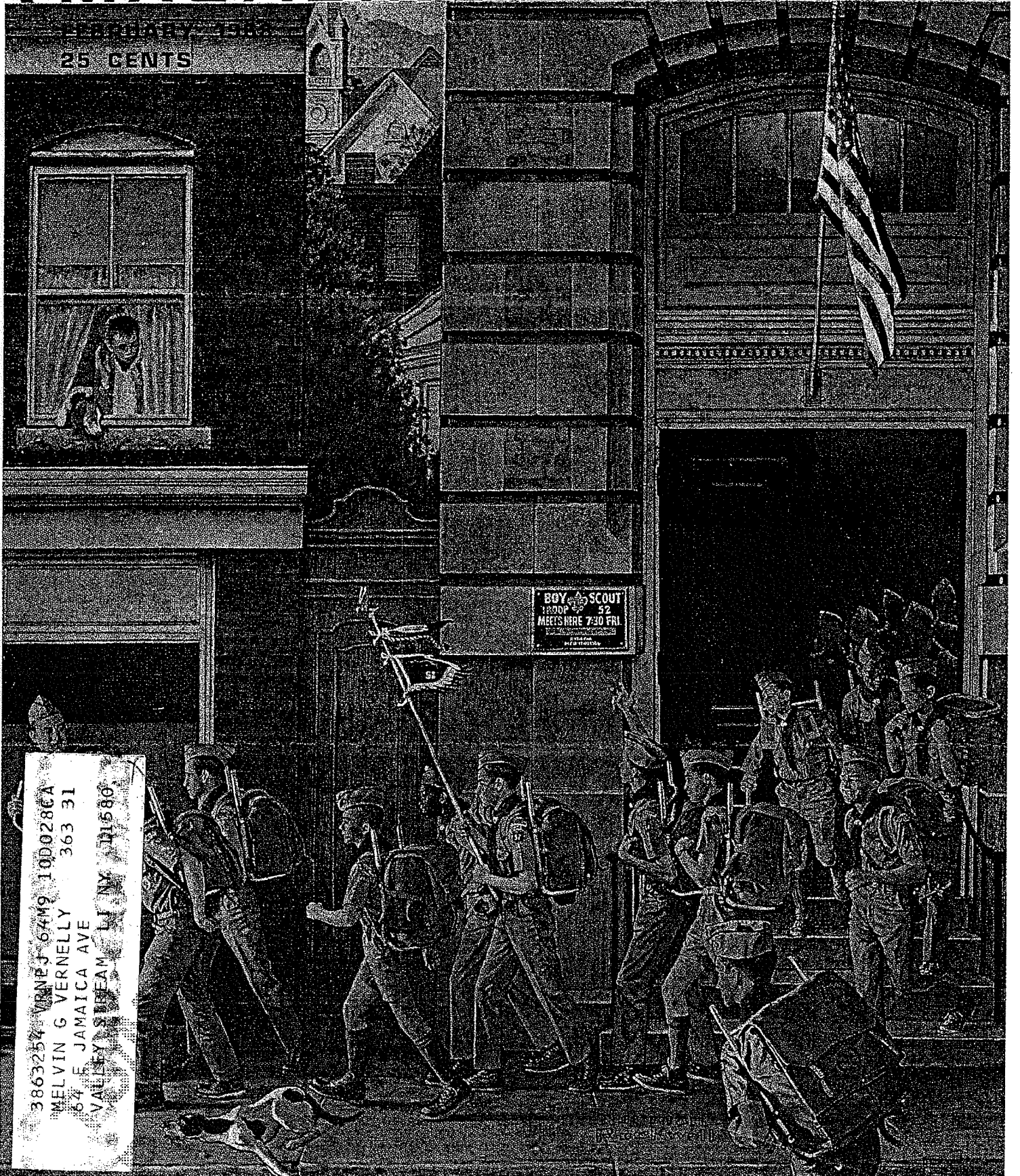

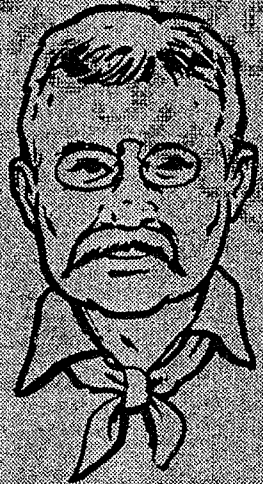
