

Here is a report on a former leader in Boulder, Colorado, whose recent conduct marks him as a candidate for the confidential file.

The man is Robert W. Wilber, 32, 2665 Kohler Drive, Boulder Colorado.

The letter dated May 25, 1963, from Carl E. Timmins, District Scout Executive, gives us further particulars on the case. Indeed, our District Scout Executive should be complimented on the excellent way in which he handled the matter, carefully avoiding any reference to the Boy Scouts of America in the news coverage

Robert Wilber is five feet, six inches tall, weighing about 130 pounds. He is a single man, employed at the Roulder Laboratories of National Standards, Department of Commerce, as scientist using very technical instruments.

The Explorer Post to which Mr. Wilber was related, expired March 31, 1963, and we received official motice from the National Bureau of Standards that they wanted to drop the charter with the thought of renewing the organization next fall. In other words, Mr. Wilber maintained no official relationship to the Boy Scouts of America at the time of his arrest.
