Dear Norman:

Thanks for the return of the identification questionnaire on Jerry D. Wintz. There is no question that he is the same individual as one on whom we have information.

We are unwilling to accept his registration, in fact, we will never again do so, knowingly, because the nature of the information we have is such as to preclude the possibility of our ever accepting him in a program where so much depends upon the character of leadership given by adults to boys.

Your letter says that the Personnel Officer of the State Reformatory in Anamosa would appreciate help in tracing Mr. Wintz's background. All that we have is his 205 Kennedy Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky address in October of 1965. He was then serving as Committeeman in Troop 1 of the Crescent Hill Methodist Church; was then 26 years of age; 5'9"; 325 lbs.; dark hair; brown eyes; an insurance adjuster; indicated he had been educated at Drake College in Iowa; and allegedly his father is a very active Scouter in Des Moines. This is all the information that I can provide to you. Once again, we are appreciative for your help.

We will refund Mr. Wintz's registration fee in a few days.

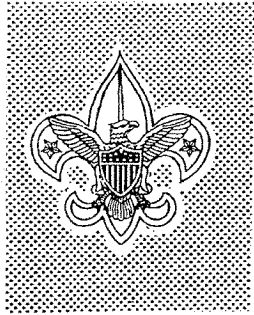

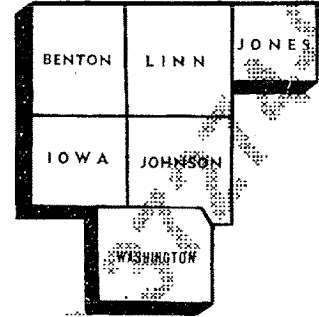

Dear Howard:

In regard to my letter with information concerning Jerry D. Wintz necessary for placing him in our confidential file, here is additional information you requested.

Mr. Wintz admitted to the minister of the Crescent Hill Methodist Church, Dr. [REDACTED], that he invited three Scouts to his apartment and displayed himself to them without any clothes on. The three boys told their parents about it and one of the boys parents told the minister. They said Mr. Wintz made immoral advances to their son.

Dr. [REDACTED] handled the entire situation. I was in contact with him as was the Scoutmaster. The troop committee chairman and institutional representative was also consulted.

Mr. Wintz has been the subject of conjecture concerning his attitude toward boys for some time. However, no charges have been placed and none are contemplated at the moment. He is out of Scouting.

Hope this answers your questions.
