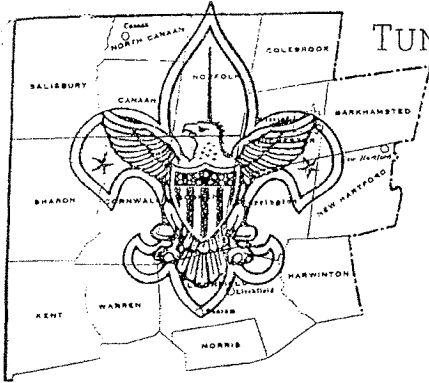

Prison Term Suspended in Morals Case

LITCHFIELD (Special) —
William S. Stone, 30, of Bantam
Lake Road, Bantam, formerly
of Torrington, charged with
risk of injury to a minor, was
given a suspended State Prison
sentence of from one year and
a day to four years by Judge
Louis Shapiro in Litchfield Su-
perior Court Thursday.

Stone was placed on probation
for five years with the under-
standing he will report frequen-
tly to the probation officer, that
probation reports on his ac-
tivity will be made frequently
and that he continue psychia-
tric treatment, which he began
several weeks ago.

State's Atty. Thomas P. Wall
told the court Stone's morals of-
fense concerned with a sev-
eral years in Torrington
on probation in
New Britain for similar
offense of a boy of 15. Wall
said recommending a State
Prison sentence.

Atty. Charles Browne, of Tor-
rington, for the defense, told
the court probation and psychia-
tric help, together with the job
Stone now holds and his recent
marriage should prove a real
aid to him in rehabilitating him-
self. The attorney made a plea
for probation with guaran-
tee of continued psychiatric
treatment.

\$2,000 Bail For Morals Counts Here

A 27-year-old unemployed machinist living in Nashua under an assumed name was ordered held in \$2,000 bail on three morals charges.

Pleading guilty in Municipal Court to three counts of an unnatural and lascivious act and one count of possession of obscene photographs, was William Francis McCarragher, of 46 Cox st. formerly of Waterbury Conn. McCarragher was living in Nashua under the name of William F. Stone.

The three morals charges involved two boys aged 15 and 16, police said. McCarragher was picked up by police on Main st Monday night. His arrest was the result of a three weeks investigation.

Following interrogation by Nashua inspectors, McCarragher, also an amateur skin diver and boat owner of some repute in the Lakes region, admitted the offenses.

This morning in court, McCarragher sat alone in the prisoners' dock, unshaven, frightened and clutching a Bible.

He pleaded guilty on all four counts and reading and examination of the charges was waived.

The respondent was also fined \$100 for possession of the obscene photos (a misdemeanor) and the other cases were transferred to the April term of the Superior Court. McCarragher's bail was set at \$2,000.
