

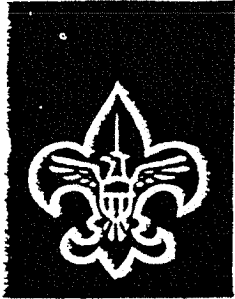

On August 7, the Nevada Police Department, with the cooperation of the Vernon County Sheriff's Department, arrested Claude Orvel Kiger, 71, 1040 N. Lynn, Nevada, on three Vernon County warrants charging him with two Counts of the Class C Felony of deviate sexual assault in the first degree and one Count of the Class D Felony of sexual assault in the second degree.

The warrants were issued following an investigation by the Nevada Police Department into the sexual assault of three male children under 17 years of age. He was released on a \$2,500 personal recognizance bond. Arraignment has been set for August 20 in Vernon County Associate Circuit Court.

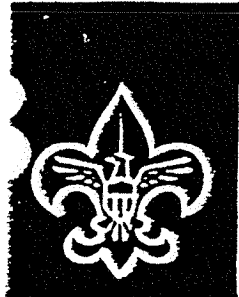

In accordance with BSA Standards of Leadership, I personally delivered the original copy of the standard suspension letter (Exhibit A attached) to Mr. Kiger at 10:32 am, August 9, 1985. Evelyn Johnson, a council member at large was in attendance. I read the letter to Mr. Kiger, asked if he had any questions, and there were none.

Charges were filed by the Assistant District Attorney, J. Lee Gutherie. I visited personally with Mr. Gutherie; Keith Brown, Defense Attorney; and Larry Moore, Nevada Police Chief. At this time the BSA has not been mentioned in any way since the incident allegedly occurred in Mr. Kiger's home, and not on any Scouting activity. All of the above are present or recent-past active Scouters, including the owner and editor of the local newspaper, which helps Public Relations-wise.

I also visited with Reverend William Cox, Pastor of the First Baptist Church, IH of Pack and Troop 55, and Mr. Kiger's pastor.

I have enclosed the Police Report and Police News Release (Exhibit 3 attached). At this time we are in a 'wait and see' mode.

Please contact me if I can be of further assistance regarding this matter.

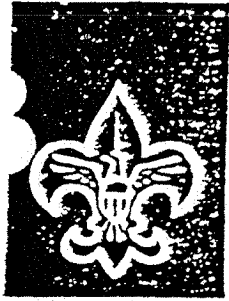

You should understand that BSA Leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.
