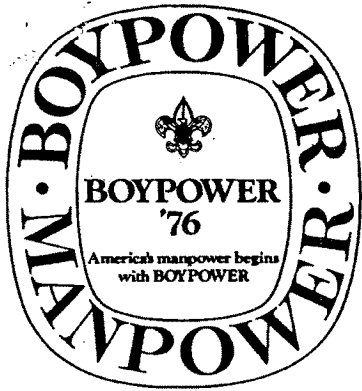


Copy of letter attached. The father of this boy knows of this letter. He is a Minister and did make contact with Mr. Heflin.

This case is closed unless charges are filed by those involved.

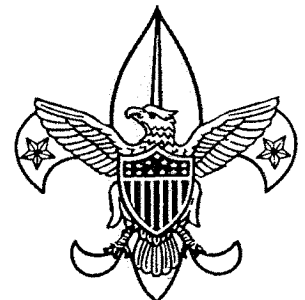

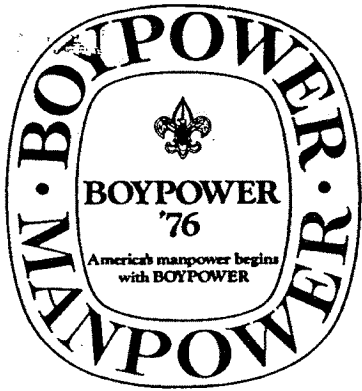

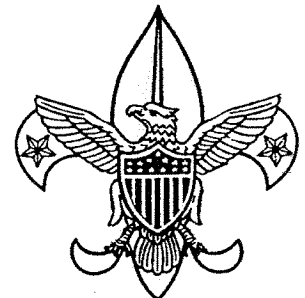
